## GUIDANCE FOR RETAIL BUSINESSES

## Overview

This document should be used to support retail businesses in reducing the risk of transmission of COVID-19. Retail businesses should also follow the <u>Workplace Guidance for Business Owners</u>.

## **COVID-19 Risk Mitigation**

Workplace	<ul> <li>Workers and patrons should be screened for COVID-19 symptoms.</li> <li>Workplaces should have a plan to ensure that any worker or patron who has any COVID-19 symptom is not permitted into the workplace.</li> <li>Businesses should follow cleaning and disinfecting practices described in the workplace guidelines, and should:</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Keep a log of daily cleaning,</li> <li>Regularly clean and disinfect any surfaces and equipment touched by workers and patrons, and</li> <li>Frequently sanitize washrooms.</li> </ul>
	<ul><li>Shopping baskets and carts should be disinfected between patron use.</li><li>Surfaces in change rooms should be cleaned and disinfected after each use.</li></ul>
	<ul> <li>Consider options that minimize the risk of spread when trying on garments.</li> <li>Encourage customers to sanitize hands before trying on clothes.</li> </ul>
	• Workplaces should keep and monitor an inventory of personal protective equipment to ensure that workers always have access to appropriate protective equipment if required.
Layout and Patron Flow	<ul> <li>Place appropriate signage around all entries and throughout the business outlining policies and procedures such as:</li> <li>Physical distancing expectations,</li> <li>Hand hygiene,</li> <li>Coughing and sneezing etiquette, and</li> <li>Cleaning and disinfection practices.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Make hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol available at as many of the following locations as possible: entrances, exits, escalators, change rooms, and checkout counters for the public.</li> <li>Consider restricting and directing customer flow into and within the business (e.g., one point of entry and exit, identify patron flow throughout the store with signage).</li> <li>Consider limiting the number of patrons allowed in the business at any given time.</li> <li>Support vulnerable populations with access to dedicated store hours, delivery or curb side pickup.</li> <li>Encourage patrons to exit the business as quickly as possible following their purchase or completion of their visit.</li> <li>Encourage curbside pickup for online purchases.</li> </ul>

## GUIDANCE FOR RETAIL BUSINESSES

Purchases	<ul> <li>Take precautions at the point of sale to reduce transmission.</li> <li>Physically distance cashiers from patrons or installing physical barriers.</li> <li>Create markers to indicate where shoppers should stand while waiting in line to maintain physical distance.</li> <li>Clean and disinfect touch screens at self check-outs between patron use.</li> <li>Space out cash counters and self-service check-outs, when possible.</li> <li>Ensure gloves are available for workers handling cash.</li> <li>Offer and encourage online or telephone orders with delivery or pick-up services as alternatives to inperson shopping.</li> <li>Update return policies to prevent the risk of transmission of COVID-19 to workers, volunteers and patrons. This may include:</li> <li>Eliminating the opportunity to return purchased goods (i.e. final sale only),</li> <li>Cleaning and disinfecting hard-surfaced, returned good prior to placing them back onto the sales floor, and</li> <li>Storing soft-surface items for a period of 24 hours prior to resale.</li> </ul>
Staff	<ul> <li>Ensure staff are trained on hygiene, sanitation and any updated policies or procedures related to preventing transmission of COVID-19.</li> <li>Encourage proper hand hygiene and coughing and sneezing etiquette.</li> <li>Ensure employees have access to hand sanitizer as required.</li> <li>Allow staff to wear masks if preferred, even if a mask is not necessary for the work they are performing.</li> <li>Stagger staff arrival and departure times, lunch times, breaks and meetings to reduce the number of workers in one place at a given time.</li> <li>Designate lockers and storage spaces to individual workers.</li> <li>Encourage staff to launder uniforms between shifts.</li> <li>Continue to follow existing occupational health and safety (OHS) requirements.</li> </ul>
