Director's Note

Welcome to Moore Theatrics' production of *Oliver! Jr.*, the Broadway Junior version of Lionel Bart's classic musical based on Charles Dickens' novel, *Oliver Twist*. The Tony and Olivier Award-winning show is one of the few musicals to win an Academy Award for Best Picture and is widely hailed as a true theatrical masterpiece by actors and audience members alike.

The streets of Victorian England come to life as Oliver, a malnourished orphan in a workhouse, becomes the neglected apprentice of an undertaker. Oliver escapes to London and finds acceptance amongst a group of petty thieves and pickpockets led by the elderly Fagin. When Oliver is captured for a theft that he did not commit, the benevolent victim, Mr. Brownlow, takes him in. Fearing the safety of his hideout, Fagin employs the sinister Bill Sikes and the sympathetic Nancy to kidnap him back, threatening Oliver's chances of discovering the true love of a family.

Oliver!, currently on the West End at the Gielgud Theatre in London, first opened in 1960 and has enjoyed multiple revivals in the decades that followed. Lionel Bart's music transcends generations, bringing young and old together at a time when finding connections is becoming increasingly difficult. I love that this production will fill the theatre with parents and grandparents who grew up watching the film or were cast as a child in a community production of the show. So, allow yourself to escape into the dark and gritty world of 1838 East London. We promise you will leave with a heart full of warmth and joy for these young performers.

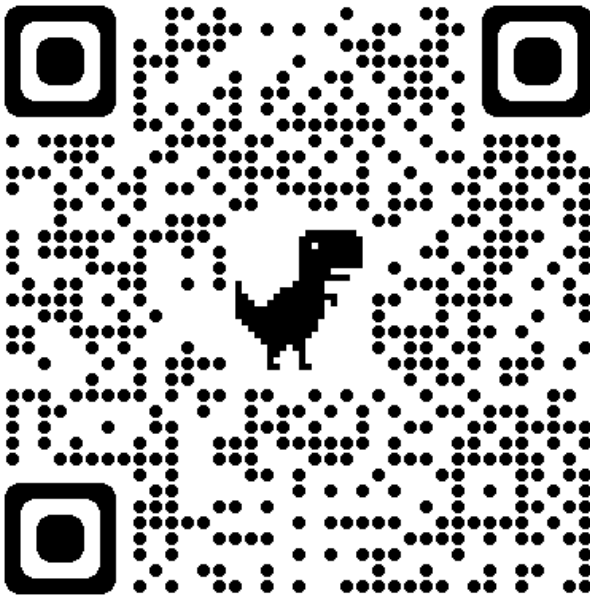
