Seven steps of prayer.

Summary: *Prayer is a way to communicate to “God”, speaking to him directly, listening, thankfulness, praising, confessing and asking for guidance or Help.*

The first step Is confession. 1st John 1:9

+Acknowledge who God is, The God of Abram, Issac and Jacob, or call him Jehovah, or Abba Father

The second step Is supplication. Ephesians 6:18

+Let your needs be requested, 2026 for me is Lord, draw me closer to you, everything else will be added onto to me according to my obedience.

*The third step. **Is adorable. Romans 12:1***

+Good morning, Holy Spirit, thank you God for who you are the one that created the earth, and made the ocean stopped at a certain place. Who else could do that but a god! And for sacrifice of Jesus Christ your son that died for our sins.

*The fourth step **Is intimacy. John 15:4***

+God, Holy Spirit, Jesus I read your word constantly to know all three of you, I do that to be close to your word in which brings me closer to you and form a relationship.

*The 5th step **Is intercession. 2nd Chronicles 6:19***

*The seventh step. **It's praise. Psalm 150:1***
