Good People,

In last month's newsletter, I wrote about the benefits of being physically active. How there is a good amount of truth behind the expression, *move it or lose it*. [\(Click here to read Pastor Steve's August newsletter article\).](#)

I then suggested the idea that the development of our faith is no different. (Not sure we ever fully lose our faith? That's content for a future newsletter!) Faith is a muscle that needs exercise. When we exercise a desire for good in this world, we build up a confidence of hope within ourselves and in others. All benefit when we intentionally engage in life building thoughts, words, and deeds when centered in the love of God in Jesus Christ. All benefit when we serve the future of God's creation.

As your pastor, I ask this question of Nativity - *How spiritually fit are we? As a community and individuals centered in Christ, how spiritually, educationally, emotionally, and missionally healthy are we?* Desiring for you to encounter the risen Christ as readily and often as possible, I invite you to immerse yourself in the life of Nativity. Below is a working list of ways in which you can serve the health of your faith at Nativity in the months of September and October:

- **Sunday 8/31 and 9/7 - Serving the Future:** A two part sermon series on the spiritual significance of responding to God's will in God's time. *Imagine, dream and hope with Pastor Steve about the future God calls Nativity to serve.*
- **Sunday 9/7 God's Work Our Hands Sunday/Camp Sunday** – This Sunday will be an awesome mashup of our Act Love Walk ministry and youth in worship leadership. *Might you give 45 minutes of your time after worship to help bag rice and beans, make cards and decorate soccer balls with words and images of love and encouragement for the communities that we serve?*
- **Sunday 9/14, 21, 28 and 10/5 – Because of God, Followers of Jesus Do For God:** A

four part sermon series on stewardship of God's gifts. *On either 9/14 or 9/21 (TBD) we will have a Ministry Fair following worship. This will be a time for ministry leaders to expo/share with you the ministry of Nativity they are passionate about, and how you can help.*

- 9/14 – Because of God, Followers of Jesus Spend Their Time Following: A sermon on contemplating what we do with our time for God. This worship will include an opportunity for you to do a spiritual gifts inventory. *Are you utilizing your God-given gifts? Do you know your gifts? If so, do you know where to begin?* (Ministry Fair? TBD)
- 9/21 – Because of God, Followers of Jesus Love God More than Money: A sermon on serving the interests of God and not wealth. (Ministry Fair? TBD)
- 9/28 – Because of God, Followers of Jesus Are Generous: A sermon on what being generous with wealth looks like.
- 10/5 – Because of God, Followers of Jesus Take Their Faith Home: A sermon on gifting the gift of faith to our family and friends.
- **Sunday 10/5 – Men's Group?** Following worship, join Pastor Steve in getting a men's group off the ground at Nativity! Bring your ideas and needs.
- **Sunday 10/26 – Fall Congregational Spending Plan Meeting.** Following worship is the presentation of the proposed 2026 Spending Plan for Nativity.

Siblings in Christ, some say *move it, or lose it*, and others - *practice makes perfect*. When it comes to life, our faith will never be perfect, but might you engage in the practice of your faith more today and tomorrow, than you have in the past. Might the church programming listed above, be a part of your engagement with God's great and merciful love for us all in Christ on the cross.

BECAUSE OF GOD'S GREAT MERCY

a stewardship program for our congregation



Good People of Nativity,

"Because of God's Great Mercy" is the title of our stewardship emphasis this year. The scriptural basis of this focus on our stewardship of all that God has entrusted into our care is I Peter 2:9, "But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness and into his marvelous light."

We begin by proclaiming all that God has done for us, hence the title "Because of God's Great Mercy." God has made us God's own people. We will also consider how generous giving is an important part of every Christian's life, and how our combined generosity can make even greater things possible through our congregation.

We will think together about how our giving to Nativity is an important part of our Christian faith, and how Nativity uses our offerings to do God's work within the congregation's walls, in our community, and around the world.

"Because of God's Great Mercy" will ask you to do two things. First, you will be asked to increase your giving to Nativity by at least $\frac{1}{2}$ of 1% of your household income. Second, you will be asked to consider giving through an automatic electronic transfer of funds. These asks of you will help Nativity serve the future God is calling us into.

"Because of God's Great Mercy" will use mail, e-mail, and time in worship to share information with you. Please make a special effort to watch for material during this important time in our congregation's life.

UPDATE: ACT LOVE WALK MOBILE OUTREACH MINISTRY

On 8/16 and 8/17 the food you donated to Act Love Walk was shared at two local extended stay motels. In all, 813 lbs. of food in 65 bags was given to 70 guests (43 kids and 27 adults)! There was prayer, ice cream smiles, kids kicking soccer balls, and a whole lot of gratitude. Thank you for supporting this ministry Nativity! Stay tuned for our next delivery date(s)!

QUICKIE CHURCH PRESCHOOL CHAPEL

Wednesdays at 8:45 a.m. is our 20-25 minute long Quickie Chapel. At Quickie Chapel we take a story from the bible and interact with it in song, dance and video. Sing and dance as much or as little as you like. No judgement here! At chapel, we also learn the Five Respects (Respect God, Respect Yourself, Respect Others, Respect Things and Respect Creation). All are welcome to join us!



Introduction to Wednesday's 8:45 AM Quickie Chapel

Inspired by last year's success and through numerous occasions, conferences, co-directors and God...We are implementing an "intro to worship" for children on a regular basis on Wednesday Mornings. Quick, geared to the very young, "nonthreatening" to all adults who bring them, uplifting, and with all the elements of worship. The following is a "quick" intro:

The resource, originally published in by ELEA (Evangelical Lutheran Education Association) , has become a staple in the library of many Pastors, Early Childhood Directors, and Children's Ministry leaders. We will use the updated, expanded version for this our current year of Quickie Children's Chapel or QCC. Opportunities s to share God's love is an important component for early childhood education in churches of the ELCA. We will use "Oh Come Let Us Worship" published by the Evangelical Lutheran Education Association as this resource is rich in ideas of how to implement. Most of the outline is detail and fits to what we want to do, with the ability to change it to fit the needs of our church community. We can create a loving environment.

"This curriculum was inspired by Marjorie Bounds, a teacher and a writer of many chapel songs. It is a simple way to share Bible stories about God's love and about Jesus' teachings about how to live and love."

Why and how does it work?

1. The service is liturgical, following the liturgy from the ELW.
2. It is predictable. The children know the responses and their part of the service.
3. Everyone is included in worship. Everyone has their parts.
4. The order of the stories loosely follows the church year. Stories begin in August with Old Testament and continue through the year to the New Testament.
5. Verses help with transitions for each part of the service...to get ready for services, as well as to take back (home/classroom)
6. The goal is that by the end of each child's time at Nativity, they will know that God loves them.

About Music

Early childhood music delivery to the children has changed drastically from just printed lyrics! Educators still use songs, dance, and movement to teach move, and play with children, but the ways to access and hear music have greatly expanded. We will download and stream songs, display lyrics, and watch song motion videos on YouTube and other video sites.

Family Newsletter

THIS MONTH'S THEME

Family & Pets

This month, your child will have the chance to discuss the people who are most important to them as they learn about who and what makes a family. They will explore ways to nurture and develop positive relationships with family members, friends and themselves. They will create a family tree collage and play with dramatic play props. Through art, music and storytelling, your child will explore their feelings. While learning about different pets, they will practice taking care of pretend pets and learn about responsibility.

At the end of the month, your child will learn character traits that will help them to be caring, generous, helpful, encouraging and cooperative.



Look for the daily notes about your child's art projects!

Today I made a dog shaker.

Dogs can make many different sounds when they bark. I created a dog shaker by filling sound-making objects. How I got to the best of me!



Today I designed a family puzzle.

Puzzles are made up of many pieces, just like a family is made up of many unique people. Puzzles help me problem solve. I designed my own puzzle and drew pictures on the pieces. We can work on the puzzle together!



ASK ME: What did you draw on your puzzle? How many pieces does your puzzle have?

preschool

Welcome to a new school year!

Start the year off right by getting your child excited about learning. Model your own enthusiasm for school and encourage them to be excited with you. Talk about the reasons why you chose your child's school program. Explain how safe it makes you feel and how much you know your child is going to enjoy it. If allowed, send a favorite photo or a small reminder of home for the first day or two.

Establish a routine when you reach the program. Help your child take care of personal items, then remember to say goodbye. Parting with a short routine and a "quick" goodbye is a great way to show your child that you trust that they will be safe. Remind your child that you, or someone else they know, will be back to pick them up at the end of the day.


