Moving at the Speed of Life

The last week of August I slowed down. As the summer sped to a close, I slowed down to 70 mph in a 16' Budget moving truck. For three days my oldest daughter Mary and I drove the same highways as we did eighteen years ago when Amy and I moved to Dubuque Iowa for me to attend seminary. Except back then, it was a 26' foot U-Haul with all five Winsors in a multi-vehicle caravan. At the time, Mary was 7, Lydia was 4, and Laurel was 2. It wouldn't be until a week before I graduated in 2012 that our youngest Mara would make us a family of six. This trip however, was just Mary and I, rolling down the interstate.

Wartburg Theological Seminary in Dubuque, IA. raised our girls for three out of four years of our seminary life. Life together at Wartburg felt, well, put together. "Put together" by God through the Spirit, for the Body of Christ assembled there on campus. Community and student life at Wartburg was, and still is, holy, and wholly purposeful in Christ's name. In my humble opinion, it's as idyllic a place as there is for intentional community in Christ. Needless to say, Wartburg is special to my family and I.

And now, even more so, as Mary has heeded a call to attend Wartburg Seminary as well. There is a lot of holy serendipity in Mary attending seminary where I did. The intimate space of a moving truck over hundreds of miles permits the mind and soul to slow down and be where it needs to be. A 1500 mile drive afforded us the opportunity to do a lot of reminiscing, and pondering of life. I call it road therapy. I bet you've experienced it as well.

While on this trip I was reminded of how beneficial to the heart, mind, and soul going back is to moving forward. Nine times Jesus went back to places of prayer and solitude to recharge for the life ahead of him (Matthew - 14:13, 14:23, 15:29; Mark - 1:12, 1:35, 1:45, 3:13, 6:46, 14:32). Simply put, so should we.

Going back to Wartburg Seminary provided moments of insight, and affirmation. The following are just a few:

It is necessary for a pastor to worship too. I attended worship twice. I did not lead. I was not responsible for anything besides just being present to hear the word of God, sing, pray, and commune. To worship in the place that taught me to be a pastor, next to my daughter who will be, was way good for the soul.

At a reception, a former professor/basketball teammate who I deeply admire said, "Steve, want to sit and talk?" I was reminded of how powerful a simple invitation to listen created the same

beautifully captive and holy space as a moving truck over 1500 miles with your child. What you need to say, might be what someone needs to hear. And, vice versa. Thanks, Big Thunder.

Conversation over good coffee with old friends and a loaf of fresh baked bread are reminders that the simplest of life's pleasures can be holy, and make you feel whole and put together when feeling out of sorts.

Thanks be to God for each of them.

Good People, might you ponder the following:

- Where might God be inviting you to slow down so you can better hear, see, or experience God's presence?
- What place, person, or memory from your past might help renew and guide you for the journey ahead?
- How can you make more room for holy conversation, simple pleasures, and meaningful relationships this week/month?

Let us pray... Gracious God, thank you for the gift of slowing down, for holy memories, meaningful conversations, simple pleasures, and places that remind us who we are, and to whom we belong. When necessary, have us to look back, so that we may move forward with renewed faith. Gather our stories, our journeys, and our hopes into your purpose. Amen.

Nativity & St. John Worship Together!

On Sunday 8/16 St. John Lutheran in Lake Park joined Nativity in worship, as well as the Bishop's staff of the Florida-Bahamas Synod: Rev. Nicole Eastwood, Assistant to the Bishop for Transition & Candidacy, and Rev. Dr. Carlos Emilio Ham, Assistant to the Bishop & Director for Evangelical Mission (South Region). Following worship, Nativity's and St. John's councils gathered at St. John's for lunch and conversation facilitated by synod staff centered on sharing our congregation's strengths, weaknesses, hopes, dreams, and how we can be stronger for God's church together. What that looks like exactly remains to be seen. There is a lot for these two congregations to prayerfully discern and explore together.



The exploration of what could be for us together continues with worship. Beginning September 13th, Pastor Steve will lead worship at St. John Lake Park on the second Sunday of the month. After leading 9AM worship at Nativity, Pastor Steve will head over to St. John to lead their 11:15AM service. This pastoral agreement runs through the end of 2026 after which Pastor Steve and the church councils will prayerfully discern if we are being led into a deeper relationship.

What can you do? Your prayer and participation is key. Hold the church councils, Pastor Steve, and yourself in prayer. Pray for God's will to be done for our congregations, and Christ's church, through you. What's next? The Lord only knows. What we do know, is that when it comes to our God, we should learn to expect the unexpected.

Dramatic Play at Home

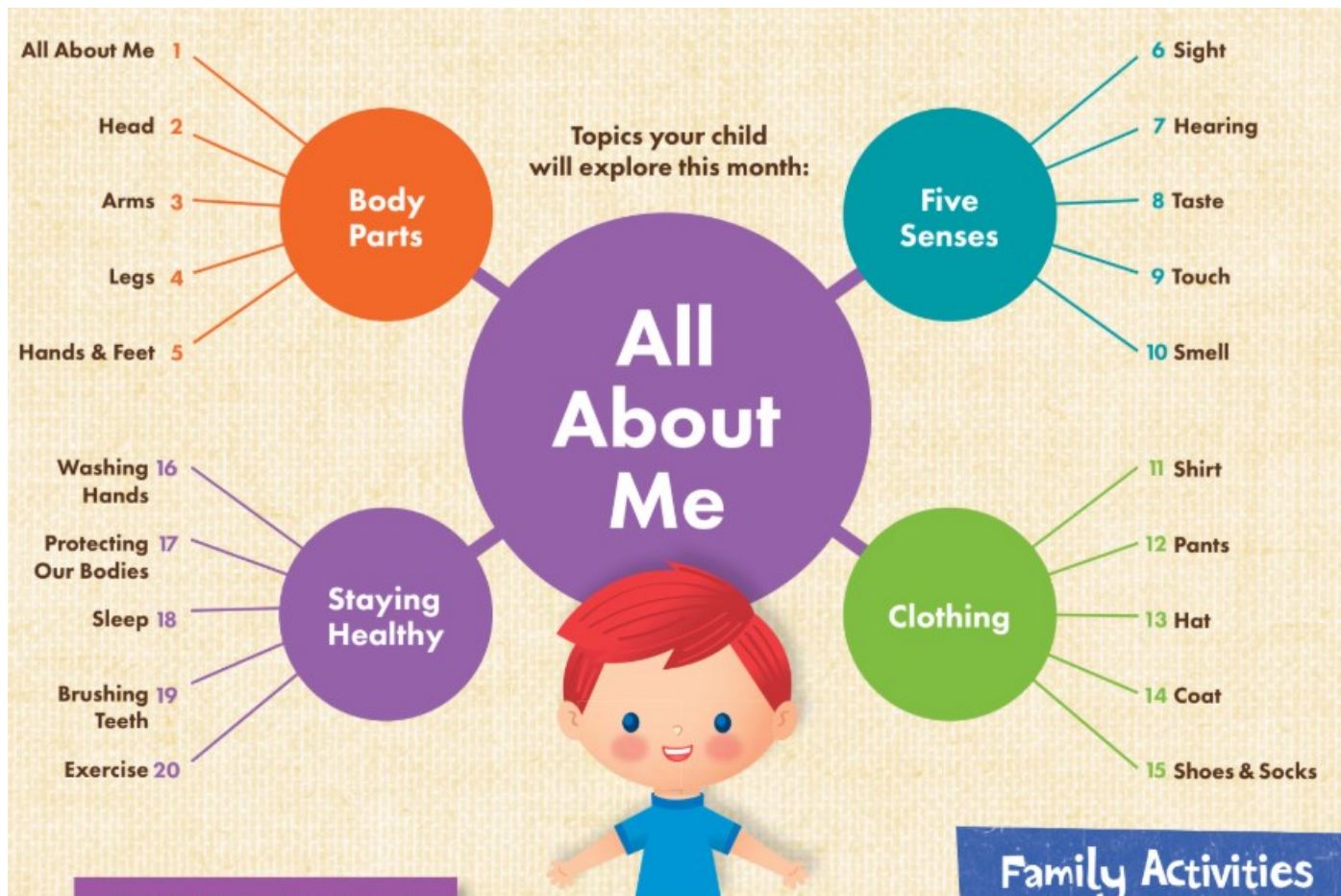
Your child loves to imitate your actions. This is both a natural and an important part of learning. When children role-play, they practice problem-solving and make sense of the world around them. Simple household items and everyday materials can inspire dramatic play and encourage creativity at home.

Dramatic play prop ideas:

- **Gather old dishes, clothes, jewelry or other household items** for pretend play.
- **Recycle or reuse materials** to create new props. For example, a PVC elbow can become a pretend telephone.
- **Save empty food containers** for use in a pretend kitchen or store.
- **Add clay, playdough or other sculpting materials** to encourage creativity during pretend play.
- **Cut out photos, characters** from cereal boxes or drawings to create play people or simple puppets.
- **Choose open-ended toys** with multiple pieces to encourage imaginative play and creativity.
- **Use boxes, baskets or containers** to help store and organize dramatic play materials.

Help your child collect items for role-playing as pirates, astronauts, rock stars and more. Adding new dramatic play materials over time can inspire creativity and imaginative play.
