Words From Steve

Good People,

Exactly twenty-eight days ago I hiked for 6 days and 60 miles with my daughter Laurel on the Appalachian Trail in southwest Virginia. Up and down mountains with 40lbs. each of life's necessities upon our backs, food, water, shelter and clothing. For roughly eight hours a day we trudged over uneven mountain terrain. Our quads quarreled with our minds - *Why are you doing this to us?!* Our shoulders shouted at us – *Did you pack bricks in this pack?* And our stomachs sniped at us – *The protein bars are getting old.* Despite that, I hadn't felt that physically alive and fit since before Laurel was born! She is now 19.

Two days ago, twenty-six days out from the hike I did a handful of hours of yard work. I repotted a few plants, planted some new ones, and put together a couple patio loveseats. Nothing too strenuous. At least it didn't seem so at the time. As I sit here writing these thoughts for you, I am super sore. My legs feel like they have been subjected to six days of nonstop mountain hiking! Sheesh...I must have lived a very sedentary life these last 26 days. I guess the old adage is true - move it or lose it.

Both up and downhill hiking are demanding. Quads burn uphill and knees ache down. What the mountain hiker really relishes is stretches of ridge walking. Ridge walking is swift and relatively easier. Figuratively speaking, I've been "ridge walking" the last twenty-six days. I best *move it, or lose it.*

The last year or so, Nativity has been all about *moving it*. We have powered through ups and downs. We have *lost* little. Nativity is getting fit for its current and future ministries. Which got me thinking, how fit are we? As a community and individuals centered in Christ, how spiritually, educationally, emotionally, and missionally healthy are we?

This fall it is my pastoral goal to lead Nativity in assessing, and then begin addressing its

individual and congregational strengths and growing edges towards a more robust outwardly faced congregation. In the coming weeks I will communicate my vision in more detail.

Good People of Nativity, for the sake of Jesus, our community, and one another, let's not ridge walk, but seek to climb and descend where the Spirit leads us, and be as alive as ever, just as the Lord intends us to be.

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Welcome and thank you for enrolling your child/children at Nativity Lutheran Church & Preschool. We are excited to start the 2025/2026 school-year together. If you have not already, you will be receiving a "Brightwheel invitation" and we are asking you to download the App to your phone. Through the app you can stay in touch with the teachers and securely check your child in and out of the preschool. All billing is done through the App as well.

Your child's first day of Preschool is Monday, August 11th, 2025.

Our Parent Orientation / Teacher "Meet and Greet "will be held on: Sunday, August 10, 2025 at 9 AM

Bring your child's backpack for a blessing, as we begin the orientation with the installation of our Teachers, during a special intro to our "quickie chapel". Then-You will have the opportunity to meet with your child's teacher and see the classrooms. This year we are not requesting supplies to be purchased by you. A \$300 supply fee will be added to your account with the August tuition. The supply fee can be paid in 2 payments and has to be paid by October 10th. Your back to school shopping made easy. Your child will be more at ease when participating on this morning as we celebrate the beginning of our preschool year. Bring your Backpack!!

Uniforms are mandatory at Nativity. Please refer to Harris Uniform: 4152 Blue Heron Blvd., Suite 118, Riviera Beach, FL 33404
Phone 561-881-8689 for all your uniform needs.

As a reminder, for your child's safety and in accordance with licensing standards, Please have your child wear closed toe shoes. Sneakers or other comfortable shoes are great.

All children need to have a current Physical (3040) and Immunization Form (680) on file to attend school.

Nativity charges an annual tuition. For your convenience, it is payable in ten monthly installments. Tuition is due on the first of each month – <u>starting August</u> 1^{st} and ending May 1^{st} . A delinquency fee will be added on the 10^{th} of the month for any remaining balance. Your child/children can return to school upon the reconciliation of your account. We accept payments in the form of cash, check, ACH (preferred), and credit cards through the App.

Smooth Morning Drop-offs

Tips for Parents



1. Talk about what's coming.

Young children thrive on predictability. In the days leading up to school, gently introduce what their day might look like.

- · Read picture books about going to school.
- · Drive by or walk past the school.
- Talk about drop-off in simple, positive terms: "You'll get to play with blocks and meet your teacher Ms. Ashley!"

2. Show them who they'll meet.

Ask the school for a picture of the teacher(s) and classroom. Familiarity eases anxiety.

3. Walk through the day together.

Explain the routine using terms they understand:

"You'll play, have snack, listen to a story, then I'll pick you up after nap."

4. Practice the morning goodbye.

Establish a predictable routine:

- · A warm hug
- A calm, confident goodbye
- · A clear statement: "I'll be back after nap time. I love you."

5. Keep it short and sweet.

Lingering = more tears. Trust your child's teacher—they know how to support kids through tough goodbyes.

6. Consider a short stay (if allowed).

Some children benefit from a 5-10 minute transition time in the room. For others, quick separation works best. Know your child.

7. Be consistent.

Use the same routine every day. If something will change, prepare them: "Today you'll go in a little later because of your doctor's appointment."

8. Make the goodbye meaningful.

Put down your phone. Make eye contact. Kneel to their level. Give a full, unrushed hug and a reassuring goodbye.

THIS MONTH'S THEME Friends & Feelings

...............................

This month, your child will learn new ways to make friends, talk to friends, be respectful of differences and express their feelings. Watch for exciting art to come home throughout the week. Take time to ask why and how your child made the projects. Your child

will also bring home games and books. Play and read together. The month is full of discovery, communication and friendship.



Start a conversation about your child's work

Each month, your child will be creating art, participating in classroom projects and sharing what they learned. Watch for exciting activities to come home and use them as communication tools to talk to your child about what they are learning.

Try asking these questions to learn more about your child's experiences:

- 1. Can you show me your favorite part of this project?
- 2. How did you make it?
- 3. Who else made a similar project? What else did you do with that friend?

It is often difficult for children to find the words to express their ideas or feelings. Use movement or visual aids to help your child show you their choices or feelings. Use this minitheme poster and ask your child to point to the way they felt during different parts of their day. Ask, "How did you feel during circle time? Snack time? Nap time?"
