### **“Building Blocks of Faith”**

***Stories of the early church that teach us the fundamentals of faith.***

Good People,

For the church season of Easter leading up to Pentecost we will explore the essential foundations of a living faith in the sermon series *Building Blocks of Faith*. Along the way, we encounter both familiar stories—like Thomas wrestling with doubt (John 20:19-31)—and often overlooked moments, such as Paul courageously engaging seekers in the Areopagus (Acts 17: 22-31). Though some passages unfold after Pentecost, they all guide us toward that Spirit-filled turning point.

These stories and others, remind us that faith begins with believing in Jesus—even when we cannot see clearly—and deepens as we learn to recognize the risen Christ in unexpected places and people. We are not meant to walk this journey alone; we are built up through living in community, where shared prayer, encouragement, and love sustain us.

Faith also grows when we ask tough questions, like Thomas did, trusting that honest seeking leads to deeper understanding. As we mature, we are called to share our faith with others, finding meaningful ways to connect across differences, just as Paul did. Along the way, we continually seek guidance from God, trusting the Spirit to lead and shape us.

Ultimately, these building blocks form a life that is open, courageous, and responsive—ready to be moved by the Spirit and sent into the world as witnesses to resurrection hope.

This month, your child will flutter into the fun world of *Birds & Eggs*. Through cheerful songs, silly bird sounds and hands-on activities, your child will explore how birds build nests, care for their eggs and raise their babies. As your child listens for chirps and discovers feathers, they'll begin to make sweet connections between how bird families care for their little ones and how you care for them every day.

**In the Nest:** Listen to bird sounds, move like birds, count birds and create simple bird-themed crafts together.

**Bird Parts:** Explore birds through movement and art, helping them notice details, build vocabulary and grow early science and motor skills.

**Tree Birds:** Discover bird life by tapping, spotting, flying and listening like different birds, building observation and motor skills through playful activities.

**Exotic Birds:** Learn about new birds through playful painting, feather-making and bird-like movements.

This activity builds your child's listening comprehension and helps them learn to follow multi-step directions.

This month, your child learned about generosity. Cook a meal with your child and share it with someone who could use a little extra care this week.	Visit the grocery store together to choose ingredients, like fruits and vegetables. Let your child touch and explore each one as you talk about its color and texture.	Working together helps your child feel included and encourages simple acts of generosity.

In the story this week, your child followed paths to different birds. Go birdwatching together to see what birds you can find.	Take a walk and count the birds you see, then lie on a blanket and watch the sky to see if any birds fly overhead.	Talking about the birds you spot builds curiosity and helps your child grow their vocabulary.



## Find the Egg

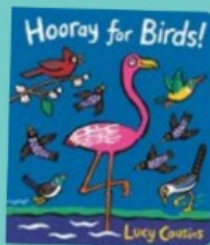
WHAT?	HOW?	WHY?
In this week's story, your child heard about a little bird hiding and being found. Play a simple hide-and-seek game together.	Hide a toy or plastic egg somewhere in the room and encourage your child to find it and bring it back.	This helps your child learn that things and people still exist even when they cannot be seen, building comfort with brief separations.

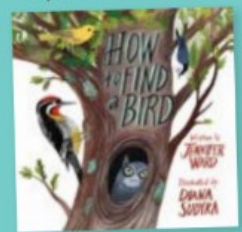

## THIS MONTH'S THEME

## Birds & Eggs

Have you ever wondered what it would be like to fly like a bird? Soar into this month's theme as you spread your wings, try on a beak and move like birds in flight. Children explore birds and their habitats through observation, movement and imaginative play. Test birdwatching skills, follow bird tracks and discover a rainbow of birds, from bluebirds and red robins to yellow hummingbirds and white bald eagles. Transform your classroom into a nest of learning.

Look for the daily notes about your child's art projects!



## Discover science around the home!

Curiosity is a natural trait in all young children. They love to ask questions, make guesses, explore, search and discover. Science is built on exploration and the search for answers. As a family, you can foster a love of science by building on your child's eagerness to learn and discover.

- **Create an environment of discovery.** Children learn best through hands-on exploration. Provide a variety of textures and experiences that engage all five senses and encourage deeper investigation.
- **Use everyday experiences to promote science.** The kitchen is one place where science naturally happens at home. When you involve your child in cooking, they can observe changes in foods (from raw to cooked), notice what happens when ingredients are combined and try measuring and pouring.
- **Explore the natural world.** Explore the outdoors together. Whether you live in the city or the country, nature is all around you. Observe birds, squirrels and other wildlife with your child, and wonder together about what foods the animals might eat. Plant flowers and watch how they change over time as they grow. If you don't have outdoor soil, try planting in a box or tub.
- **Encourage wonder and curiosity.** Ask questions that begin with "I wonder...", "What if..." or "How can we find out..." to encourage further investigation.
- **Show your child how to record information.** Invite them to draw or write about something you're exploring together. Talk about what sparked your curiosity, what you did to find out more and what happened. Follow up by wondering together about what you might try next to keep exploring together.

Discuss the dangers birds might face and how you could help. Decide as a family what you would like to do for the birds. For example, you may build a bird house, grow flowers or pick up garbage to keep their area clean.
