Cross, Prayer Walk, Talk & Listen:

A Listening in Lent Project to Benefit Nativity's Preschool

Hi Good People! Pastor Steve here. This Lent, I invite you to join me in a powerful prayer practice. During the season of Lent I'll be walking Nativity's church property with an 8ft. wooden cross, praying and listening to God. Jesus told his disciples, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me." (Matthew 16:24) What does that mean? It means, Jesus is calling us to live like Him in an others-focused, God-honoring life. We do this by devoting ourselves to God, listening to what He says, and loving others.

Join me for a time of walking, talking, and intentional listening to God, and one another. What others-focused, God honoring life, is the Spirit calling Nativity Lutheran into at the corner of Holly and Plant? And what others-focused, God honoring life is God calling you too? Or, do you need to "vent in Lent"? Let's pray and listen, together. Questions? Doubts? Let's pray and listen, together. God wants nothing more than for us to be present with, and listen to one another. The Lord knows we need it. This is literal, figurative, and spiritual cross-carrying. You are invited to help me carry the cross, but are not required to. If needed, we can walk the level parking lot. All spaces of God's creation deserve prayer.

Besides building community, and strengthening relationships with God and one another, you can help strengthen Nativity's preschool ministry by donating to the tuition assistance fund. All monies will help pay for quality Christian education and childcare for those who cannot afford it, but desire it for their child. Truly others focused and God honoring.

My goal is to cross-walk a total of 40 miles by the end of Lent on April 2nd .


NATIVITY BLANKET FUNDRAISER



THIS MONTH'S THEME

Pond Life

Pack a picnic and meet us at the pond for a month of learning about frogs, ducks, fish, snails, turtles and more! Become scientists and build a pond habitat. Paint with algae, relax on a lily pad and count dragonflies as you observe pond life from different perspectives.

What animals and insects live in and around the pond? What plants grow there? It's a place teeming with life and activity, and you'll dig in and explore it all!

Look for the daily notes about your child's art projects!




Practice math at home!

Math is all around us from the day we are born. "When was he born?" "How much did they weigh?" "How long was she?" Encourage the children to see the math in their everyday lives by having fun with it at home.

- **Count, count, COUNT!** Count the steps you take, the cars you see on the road, the flags and the animals to help your child connect counting and numbers.
- **Point out numbers in daily activities**, such as phone numbers, numerals on a clock, dates, times, addresses, microwave and television displays, recipes and more.
- **Invite your child to help you measure when following recipes** or working on household projects.
- **Find items around the home to sort**, such as laundry, buttons or books. Use words such as "more" and "less" to compare the piles.
- **Create a homemade hopscotch or tossing game** and invite your child to write the numbers with chalk or on paper to use in the game.
- **Seriate items around the home** by placing them in order from smallest to largest, shortest to tallest or lightest to heaviest.
- **Allow the children to handle, count and play with coins and dollars** to become familiar with monetary units.

When math feels fun and positive, children naturally lean in with curiosity. Share your excitement when you notice numbers and counting throughout your day. Your enthusiasm helps your child see math as something enjoyable to explore.

This month, we're exploring the wonders of Pond Life! Together we'll discover the plants, insects and animals that make the pond their home. Through songs, stories and hands-on play, your toddler will use their senses to see, hear and feel the beauty of nature while growing curious about the world around them. You can join in the fun at home by noticing birds, bugs or puddles together and talking about what you see in your own neighborhood.

Life Around the Pond: Listen to the sounds of water, birds and frogs together or look at pond pictures in a favorite book.

Pond Plants: Offer your child safe leaves or flowers to touch and smell or explore green-colored sensory play at home.

Pond Insects: Skate like a water strider or buzz like a dragonfly as pretend play helps children explore movement and sound.


Life in the Pond: Explore water with cups, bowls or bath toys while splashing, pouring and pretending to meet pond animals.

This month, your child learned about the color black. Have fun looking for black items together around your home.	Show your child something black and keep spotting it throughout the day, saying "Look, black!" each time you find it.	Noticing and naming colors helps your child build early color recognition and language skills.


Snap at Vocabulary




WHAT?	HOW?	WHY?
