FORMAL REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION AND RECORD INTEGRITY

To avoid unnecessary motion practice and to narrow the issues currently before the regulatory and appellate bodies, I require direct, written responses to the following four items by **Monday** :

- **Proof of Service for May and June 2025 Ledgers:** Please produce the native transmission logs or objective proof of service confirming that your complete, unredacted billing statements—specifically encompassing May and June 2025—were properly served upon me prior to the entry of the fee award.
- **Timeline for Remedial Action (Colo. RPC 3.3):** Please provide the exact date by which your firm intends to correct the civil court record regarding the June 16, 2023 Witness Disclosure. You have relied upon this disclosure's validity in civil court, yet affirmatively conceded to the DORA Board of Accountancy that the designation of Mr. Freedberg was a "typographical mistake". Please explain how these contradictory positions will be reconciled.
- **DORA Proceeding Records:** Please provide a copy of your most recent responsive submission to DORA regarding Mr. Freedberg, or affirmatively confirm in writing that no such response was filed.
- **June 11, 2025 Courtroom Coordination:** State definitively, yes or no, whether any attorney, paralegal, or representative associated with Lewis Brisbois was physically present in or immediately outside the courtroom on June 11, 2025. Furthermore, confirm whether your unredacted billing records for May and June 2025 contain any time entries reflecting coordination with Ms. Glassman or her team regarding that hearing.

I am asking for objective records and clear positions so the service dispute and the integrity of the transmitted materials can be addressed cleanly. If you refuse to provide this basic clarification, I will append this correspondence to my forthcoming filings to demonstrate a continued pattern of concealment.
