Position Description

The Community Impact Fellow at The Dallas Foundation will work as an integral part of the grants department at a fast-paced community foundation. During an 8-week period this summer, the Fellow will:

- Research and identify indicators and measurable outcomes for our priority issue areas
- Summarize research findings and provide recommendations for strategic community investment
- Assist in establishing shared measurement practices for The Dallas Foundation initiatives
- Consult with other community foundations to learn how they measure impact
- Develop a process for reporting on progress toward defined community metrics
- Learn about best practices in grantmaking

Requirements

Applicants must:

- Be a currently enrolled undergraduate student who will be returning to college full time (minimum of 12 credits per semester) as a sophomore, junior or senior in the fall of 2019,
- Have an interest or career aspirations in the field of philanthropy, and
- Have the ability to work 35 hours per week, for at least 8 weeks, **between May 13 and August 23, 2019.**

This is a paid internship; a stipend will be provided.
