Portuguese Water Dog exhibitors and fanciers have a long-standing reputation for maintaining their Specialty Headquarters and Show Site in excellent condition. Rings, grooming areas, and hotel rooms occupied by attendees are expected to be left clean and undamaged after the Specialty concludes.

To help uphold this standard, the following policies will be enforced during Specialty Week:

- There will be no grooming of dogs in hotel rooms. Grooming will be permitted only in the area set aside for that purpose.
- 4. NO dogs shall be washed in hotel bathtubs; and hotel towels are NOT to be used on dogs for drying them or other grooming purposes.
- 5. The external and internal premises of the hotel and show site must be kept free of debris and feces caused by the presence of dogs attending the Specialty. Everyone must pick up after their dog(s).
- 6. The Show Committee may be called upon to inspect a room because of signs of unusual wear or damage due to the presence of dog(s), and will enforce appropriate damage compensation to the hotel as necessary. AKC considers show hotels a part of the show site and subject to Bench Committee hearings and discipline.
- 7. All dogs will be on leash at all times except when competing in performance events.
- 8. We have a beautiful Show Site Clean and Pristine. At the end of each day, we would like to see it the same way!
- 9. Golf cart rental on the property is not available.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might
 reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than
 the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
