We will have boat rowing lessons and opportunities to see and try training methods for water trials.

Bring your PWD on a simple collar or body harness with a 6-foot or shorter leash (no retractable leashes please), bring poop pick-up bags, training treats, lunch and water for you and your PWD, and sunscreen. Wear water shoes or athletic shoes that you don't mind getting wet.

You may want to bring: Folding chair, crate for your PWD to rest in, water equipment, floating toys, a long line, personal floatation device (life jacket) for you and your PWD (if you have them). There are trees that provide shade, but you can bring a shade canopy. No tarps or tents with floors are allowed on the grass. There are no stakes allowed to hold canopies from blowing away! If you need to secure anything, bring weights, sandbags, or water jugs for this purpose.
