The Garrett Phillips Memorial scholarship program is intended to provide financial assistance to students planning to enroll in a career tech. training, apprenticeship, or internship program. The scholarship is in memory of Robertsdale High School Class of 2020 graduate, Garrett Phillips. Garrett or "G" as friends affectionately called him and family was a good student, extremely polite and respectful. Rather than traditional classroom work, Garrett preferred outdoor activities and working with his hands and spent his junior and senior years attending South Baldwin Center for Technology. Garrett was enrolled to start a welding training program the day following his untimely passing. To remember and honor the incredible young man "G" was, Central Baldwin Sunset Rotary Club provides scholarships to deserving students seeking to pursue career tech training.

Examples of programs include, but are not limited to: **Automotive Technology, Aviation, Building Construction, Computer Technology, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Cybersecurity, Fire Science, Graphics & Design, Health Sciences, Horticulture, HVAC/Plumbing/Electrical, Utility Lineman, Industrial Maintenance, Instrumentation Technology, and Welding.**

Scholarships are awarded in the amount of **\$2,500** based on full-time and part-time enrollment. The awards will be paid to the student and/or training program upon confirmation of enrollment. The scholarship is intended to support the career tech training of the recipient and may be used for tuition, program fees, equipment, books, or other expenses as approved by committee. - ⇒ High School senior seeking higher education or training in a Career Tech Field
- ⇒ Grade Point Average of 2.5 or above

- ⇒ Provide a brief written statement describing your plans/goals for the future, estimated cost to attend training program or tools/equipment needs, and how this scholarship will help you achieve your plans/goals.
- ⇒ Provide a letter of recommendation, preferably from a current or former instructor and school transcript.
