2021-22

GOAL for 2022: To raise the rest of the funds needed to finish the “Phase 1” upgrades for the CCHS Tennis Court Facility on campus.

This will transform the courts into a true A+ facility!

These upgrades will help to maximize the community’s use of the courts as well as to greatly improve the courts and grounds for the CCHS’ Men’s and Women’s Tennis Programs.

Total raised so far: \$41,102 as of February, 2022

Balance outstanding: \$13,000-\$15,000+

The CCHS tennis court compound
(originally funded by a capital campaign spearheaded by CC At Play)
continues to get a lot of use by the community:
CCHS club tennis, Callen Tennis instruction, lessons,
pickleball enthusiasts, training wheel bike riders,
and for general recreational play.
It has also served as a tremendous venue for our CCHS Men’s
and Women’s teams for practices and competitions.
(winners of many State Championships throughout the years!)

Phase 1 projects (BLUE) indicates already funded with installation planned for this spring while red indicates project funding still needed:)

- Two permanent benches (with shade covering) for players/spectators next to the courts (\$10,000)
- A storage shed to provide much needed space to keep gear, balls, and chairs (\$10,000)
- SCOREBOARD (partially/eventually powered by solar): (\$25,000-\$30,000) A permanent scoreboard for displaying live scoring for home matches and tournaments hosted at the site.

ESTIMATED funds needed to complete this final project: \$13,000-\$15,000+
