Responsibility

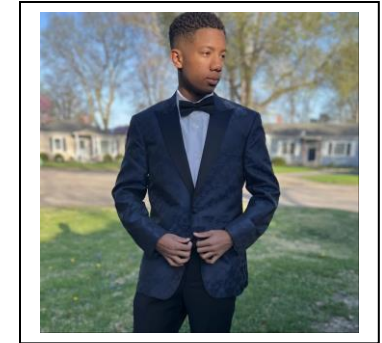
Restraint
