ALLSTATE DRIVING INSTRUCTION

Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, Assumptions of Risks and Indemnity Agreement

Definitions in this Agreement:

- A. The term “driving instruction and activities” shall include an instruction provided by any agent, employee, or substitute of Allstate Driving Instruction. It also includes all activities, services, and use of vehicles, either provided by or arranged by Allstate Driving Instruction. This definition also includes activities which are in any way related to either driving, stopping for any reason, classroom instruction, waiting for class to start, waiting after classes, movement in and around vehicles, and any other activities **occurring because of class or driving related to driving times or class time.**
- B. The term “agents” shall include an instructor, owner, subcontractor, substitute or other aid for Allstate Driving Instruction.

Assumption of Risk:

I am aware that driving, learning to drive, and any activity associated with this course involves risks, dangers, and hazards as well as the potential for serious injury and crashes.

I fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage, or loss resulting from.

Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims, and Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of the agents and Allstate Driving Instruction allowing me to participate in Driver Education, I hereby agree as follows:

- 1. TO WAIVER ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I have or may have in the future against the agents and/or Allstate Driving Instruction and TO RELEASE these agents and Allstate Driving Instruction from any and all loss, damage, expense, or injury including death that I may suffer as a result of driving instruction and activities. DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE, INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWED UNDER THE OCCUPIERS LIABILITY ACT, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 337, ON THE PART OF THE AGENTS, AND INCLUDING THE FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE AGENTS TO SAFEGUARD OR PROTECT ME/MY CHILD FROM THE RISKS, DANGERS AND HAZARDS OF DIVING.
- 2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any property damage or personal injury to any third party resulting from my participation in Driver Education, Driving Instruction, or activities.
- 3. That this Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives, in the event of my death or incapacity.
- 4. This Agreement and any rights, duties and obligations as between the parties to this Agreement shall be governed and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of Vermont and no other jurisdiction. 5. I CONFIRM THAT I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THIS AGREEMENT PRIOR TO SIGNING IT, AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I AM WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS WHICH I OR MY HEIRS, NEXT OF KIN EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS, ASSIGNS AND REPRESENTATIVES MAY HAVE AGAINST THE AGENTS. In signing this agreement I agree to not bring any lawsuit against Allstate Driving Instruction or any of its agents.

Allstate Policy Manual

Course Fee: The Course fee and any additional fees assessed should be PAID IN FULL before the end of the class in order for the Completion certificate to be issued.

Refund Policy: Fees are NON REFUNDABLE once paid.

Attendance: Attendance is mandatory for the entire course.

No Show/Absentee : When a student fails to show up for a scheduled class or drive or fails to notify the instructor prior to an absence, \$35 fee would be assessed for a make up session. More than two NOSHOW'S or remaining ABSENT from class on two consecutive occasions or more will result in TERMINATION.

Removal from the Driver Education Program: Students will be dropped from the DE program with a "Fail" grade for any of the following:

1. Excessive tardiness & Excessive absences.
2. Failure to complete assigned work.
3. Use of Foul and Abusive language ,and Cheating
(whether sharing or receiving answers)
4. Being under the influence of alcohol or any other illegal drug during any of the instructional phases.
5. Misuse of Driver Education Equipment.
6. Repeated and willful violation of traffic laws.
7. Use of Cell Phones, Text Devices and other personal handheld electronics is prohibited unless approved by your DE Instructor.

Please Note:

A Minimum grade of 80% is required to pass the course.

If a Student 'Fail's the grade than he can register again at the start of next class for a fee or retest at a cost of \$ 35 per time until satisfactory score is achieved.

If a Student passes the classroom assessment, but is unable to demonstrate proper driving skills, Allstate Driving Instruction has the right to withhold certification, until the student has demonstrated satisfactory driving skills.

We may be required to Record the performance of all students via audio and video recording devices, if needed for educational purposes.

Parents'/Guardians' Can Help: Take an early interest in the progress of you son/daughter. When such violations are observed, the student will be removed from the DE course. The Vermont State Patrol, the DMV and DE instructors all recognize the importance of practical driving opportunities for the learner. Thus, we suggest that you provide opportunities for your student driver to practice.

Talk with you teen driver about their progress in both the classroom and the in-car phases throughout the course. There are several ways to help your teen driver **during and beyond** the course:

1. Set a good example when you drive
2. Keep your student accountable for assigned course work and attendance. Ask for, review and sign off on every in-car lesson
3. Provide a vehicle for practice sessions
4. Plan each session based on the suggestions sent home by the teacher
5. Reinforce the skills taught by the Driver Education teacher. If differences come up please contact the instructor for clarification.
6. Make sure the student is familiar with all controls and safety devices in each of the family vehicles
7. Remain calm! A soft, steady voice is most helpful
8. Explain: Do not assume your teenager knows what you want them to do
9. Give all directions clearly, calmly and well in advance of the Maneuver
10. Be Ready to assist with verbal steering guidance as well as guidance well in advance of trouble
11. While riding remember you are the responsible driver of the car so that you are always scanning the driving scene and ready to react to any driving situation
12. Expect your students to make mistakes. Separate physical errors (turning the wheel too soon) from mental errors. Look for positive situation to make positive compliments.

An Additional \$ 25.00 fee will be assessed for any returned or bounced Checks.
