## Saskatchewan Archery Association Inc. Policies and Procedures

## DRESS CODE POLICY

The Saskatchewan Archery Association (SAA) Dress Code Policy applies to all individuals on the field of play during Provincial events.

- Must present a professional, athletic appearance while on the field of play.
- Skin-tight, torn, ripped (see examples below) or heavily soiled clothing articles are not allowed.
- Shorts, skorts and skirts must be professional in appearance and length (no shorter than the fingertips).
- Camouflage and denim will be allowed. Please note that for National and International events camouflage and denim may not be allowed. Refer to Archery Canada Rule Book 2 for more information.
- Leggings/yoga-type stretch pants are allowed, but must not be transparent/translucent.
- Shirts must have sleeves and cover the front and back of the body. The midriff shall be covered at full draw.
- Footwear must cover the entire foot.
- At no time will any article that bears wording, insignias, innuendo or images determined by SAA to be
  offensive or inappropriate be allowed on the field of play.

## **Policy Enforcement**

- The SAA technical delegate and/or representative have final discretion on the implementation of the Dress Code Policy.
- Violations of the Dress Code Policy at any time while on the field of play must be reported to the SAA technical delegate/representative and/or the Head Judge.
- Individuals who do not comply with the Dress Code Policy will be asked to leave the field of play.

## **Examples of Torn/Ripped Clothing NOT Allowed**

Below are examples that are NOT permitted within the policy intent due to being torn, ripped, having holes or fray at the hem typically as a result of wear and tear or otherwise modified.
