COMPETITION APPEALS

Jury of Appeal

- A Chairman of a Jury of Appeal shall be appointed by the SAA Board of Directors and Host Club for every SAA Championship.
- Upon receipt of an appeal, the Chairman of the Jury of Appeal will appoint two impartial and knowledgeable Jury members who are not involved as a subject of the appeal from the following list (not in any order and not limited to the following):
 - A Judge who is present but not competing;
 - A SAA Director who is not competing;
 - A Coach, who is not competing;
 - o If necessary, impartial, knowledgeable competitors in a different category from the appellant.
 - o The technical delegate should not be a member of the jury.
- The decision made by the Jury of Appeal is final.

Appeals Process

- Appeals against rulings by the Judges shall be presented, in writing, by the archer and must include the rule violation.
- Appeals must be submitted by filling out the SAA Competition Appeals Form and submitting the appeals fee.
- Archers have 30 minutes from completion of the round to submit an appeal.
 - During Match Play, intention to appeal must be discussed with the technical delegate and/or head judge within 5 minutes after the match ends. The archer will then proceed to complete required appeal process.

Fees

- The Competition Appeal fee is \$200
- If the appeal is upheld, the fee will be returned to the archer.
