One-sentence Pitch, Mission, and Organizer's Manual.

1. One-Sentence Pitch

> United Uprising is a grassroots training and action movement dedicated to dismantling the centralized banking and lobbying systems—especially the Federal Reserve and the foreign influence networks centered on AIPAC and Israel's government—that keep Americans in debt, divided, and subdued; we teach and deploy the very tactics used against us to restore sovereignty to the people.

This is the single sentence every organizer should be able to say to anyone, anywhere.

2. Mission Statement

We are not a reform committee. We are a peaceful but relentless counterforce. United Uprising exists to identify, expose, and dismantle the systems that keep the American people in economic and political servitude—especially the Federal Reserve, centralized banking networks, lobbying arms like AIPAC, and the foreign influence operations they sustain.

We do this by:

Training everyday citizens in the tactics and methods elites use to maintain control.

Arming our members with the mental, psychological, and organizational tools to counter subversion at every level.

Building a nationwide network of chapters that shows up in public weekly, online daily, and at every decision-making table where lobbyists and foreign agents have infiltrated.

Reclaiming the financial and political sovereignty of the American people by relentlessly targeting the institutions that keep them in power.

WE'RE DISCIPLINED, ORGANIZED, AND UNSTOPPABLE!

3. Core Principles

- Relentless Visibility: We will not quiet down, hide, or be ignored. We will be everywhere the public is, every week.
 - Counter-Tactics Training: Members learn to recognize manipulation, infiltration, and psychological operations and to neutralize them.
 - Focus on the Root, Not the Branches: We go after the systems that keep elites in power — not their distractions.
 - Unity of Action: Left or right does not matter. Sovereignty matters.
 - Peaceful but Uncompromising: We operate within the law but never surrender our ground.
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4. Organizer's Guide: How to Gain Members & Build Chapters

Step 1. Lead with the Pitch

Every organizer must know the one-sentence explanation (above). This is your hook.

Step 2. Recruit Strategically

You're not just looking for "people who agree." You're looking for people who are:

- influential in their community (teachers, veterans, small business owners, students).
- Already active (church leaders, civic club members, volunteers).
- Ready to learn new tactics.

Step 3. Where to Recruit

- Farmers' markets, fairs, parades, camping & hunting expos.
- Rotary, Lions, Kiwanis, and veterans' clubs, **churches**
- College campuses (tabling and chalking high-traffic zones).
- Town Hall, City Council, and School Board meetings.
- Courthouse steps, public squares, and downtown sidewalks.
- Social Media, sporting events, conventions, concerts

Step 4. Follow Up Immediately

Get their contact info. Add them to your chapter chat that same day. Invite them to the next training or event. Give them a small, concrete job.

5. Weekly Visibility Plan

A chapter must appear in public at least once a week. Options include:

- Attending local government meetings and speaking during public comment.
- Setting up information tables at fairs, farmers' markets, and festivals.
- Hosting open-air discussions on college lawns or courthouse steps.
- Holding teach-ins at libraries or coffee shops about lobbying, the Fed, and foreign influence.
- Public banner drops and leafleting at high-traffic intersections.

Rule: If the community doesn't see you every week, you're invisible.

6. Training Program

Every member should receive basic training in:

- Subversion & Infiltration Awareness (recognizing manipulative tactics, astroturfing, and co-opting).
- Psychological Operations 101 (how elites control narratives, and how to counter them).
- Krav Maga / Self-Protection (optional for physical self-defense during activism).
- Community Organizing & Public Speaking (how to deliver a message that cuts through).

We are creating citizens who can see through propaganda and manipulation and teach others to do the same.

7. Setting Up Public Discussions & Debates

College Campuses

- Reserve space via Student Activities.
- Frame event as “**Sovereignty Forum**” or “**End the Lobby State.**”
- Partner with any club that values free speech or government reform.
- Use flyers, chalk, posters, flags, banners, commercials, and QR codes, etc., to advertise.

Municipal Spaces

- City Halls and libraries usually have reservable rooms.
- Call it a “Civic Education Night.”
- Invite local press to cover.

Public Spaces

- Parks, courthouse steps, downtown plazas = free speech zones.
- Use signage and a portable PA.& Record video for online content.

8. The Organizer’s Weekly Checklist

- Did I recruit at least one new person?
- Did my chapter appear in public this week?
- Did we teach our members a new tactic or skill?
- Did we post content online to expand reach?
- Did we plan our next action?

**If you check all five boxes every week,
your chapter will grow and become a force.**

9. Key Messaging Phrases
