

Mrs. Lisa's 2025-2026 Pre-K Class

We are so excited that you have chosen Lil' Flippers Preschool for your child. It is a wonderful place for students to grow and learn. We have the privilege of including God's truth in everything that we teach. We are also here to partner with you this year and will be praying for you and your families. Helpful hints for parents:

- 1. Check backpacks for folders. We ask that each child have a school-sized backpack. A folder will be provided by SCA to send home your child's work on their last day of school for that week and any notes that we may need to get to you. You may also use the folder to send notes or forms to me. Please keep your child's folder in their backpack. Tuition money should be submitted to the business office.
- 2. Important Information will be sent via email. The most efficient way to contact us is through email.
- 3. Label your child's name on their backpack, lunch box, water bottle, sweaters, and coats. Please have your child wear clothes that they can play in, tumble in, be messy in, and are easy for them to pull up and down. Shorts must be worn under dresses or skirts. Leggings and sweatpants can be worn in cooler weather. Shoes should be easy to take off and put back on. Girls' hair should be in a ponytail or pulled back.
- 4. Fun Days- We will have fun days during the school year: Thanksgiving, Christmas, Valentine's Day, Easter, and the End of the Year.
- 5. Snacks- Students will have a snack every morning. These snacks will be provided by SCA. Everyone has the same snack, but there will be a different snack every day.

- 6. Our "All About Me Board" Gives each child the opportunity to be the "Star". Each child will display pictures of their family, pets, vacations, grandparents, etc., for everyone to enjoy.
- 7. Show and Tell To support letter recognition, each Wednesday, we will ask the child to bring an item that starts with the letter of the week. This will start the fifth week of school.
- 8. Birthdays- Your child may bring a special treat to share with his/her classmates. You may bring fruit cups, cookies, or mini cupcakes. We will celebrate during our snack time. If you would like to do something different, please visit with Ms. Lisa to discuss your wishes and to see what is feasible for the class. We will celebrate summer birthdays in May.
- 9. Lunches- We encourage you to send a healthy lunch containing protein, fruit, and/or veggies. Each day, we will remind everyone he/she will need to eat their healthy lunch items first before his/her dessert. Please refrain from sending soft drinks, candy, and gum. Thermos containers work well if your child prefers warm meals.
- 10. Drop Off- You may pull up under the portico, and we will help your little one to and from the classroom. Of course, you may also park and walk your child to and from the classroom.
- 11. Water Bottles- Your child needs a water bottle/thermos for tumbling/free gym time. Your child's water bottle/thermos should be labeled with your child's first and last name. We would prefer water bottles with straws or a flip top that will close securely, lessening the chance of spilling.
- 12. Preschool begins at 9 am and ends at 2 pm. Being on time each day is important for your child's and the class's structure and routine. You may arrive at 8:50 to give your precious little one free time before our daily routine begins. We will start our class time at 9 am. Pick-up will begin at 1:45 pm for any parents wanting to pick up early. If for any reason you need to pick up before 1:45 pm, please let us know that way, so that we can have your child ready for you.
- 13. Conferences- We will be happy to confer with you anytime during the year to discuss your child's progress. Email and we can set up a time.
- 14. Discipline- The children will take an active part in developing self-discipline in our classroom. We will give grace in the beginning as we are learning classroom rules and what is expected. We will be using positive reinforcement through praise and redirection as needed. A time-out (thinking time) will be used if a child is unable to follow directions, being redirected, or being disrespectful to classmates or adults.
- 15. Weather Alerts- We follow Klein ISD for school closures during inclement weather.
