Docent:

The docents usually camp one or several nights at the lighthouse, so will need a tent, sleeping bag and outdoor cooking gear. You'll need a long rope to store your food on a tree limb to keep out the small animals and keep a tidy camp. Remember, there is no fresh water, no electricity and you pack out all of your trash and leftovers. You would open the lighthouse at set times, and help visitors find the information they want. Maintenance Committee:

If you like working outdoors with gardening tools, come be a volunteer on the maintenance team of 8. Each person is given a safety talk and an assignment for the day or half day. You would sometimes be hot, sometimes cold, but usually just right to enjoy the day cleaning up around the lighthouse and the island. Check here / /

NOTE: Docent and Maintenance persons are coordinated through the Committee Chairman, and are able to ride on State Parks boats to and from Brandt's Landing on Orcas Island to Patos Island. Chairmen arrange the rides and provide additional information. Private rides are permitted, so long as the Chairman is aware of the arrangements.
