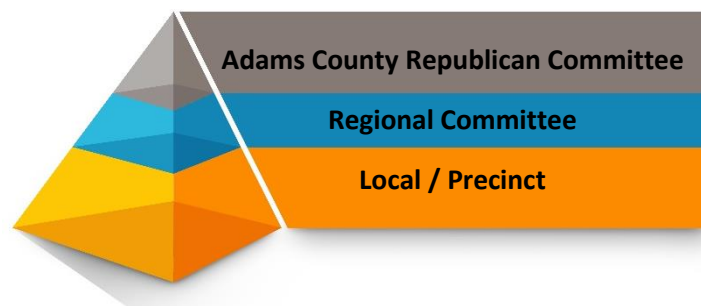


Organization

Adams County Republicans are represented by a three-tiered organization.

- Adams County Republican Committee
 - A corporation (the Agency) governed by published bylaws.
 - Composed of duly elected and appointed Committee Members from each precinct.
 - Board of Directors (BOD) consists of elected and appointed officers and Seventeen (17) elected Regional Captains and Co-Captains who represent every Committee Member in Adams County. See Committee/BOD Structure on page one (1).
- Regional Committee Organization
 - The entire county is divided into 17 regions. Each region is comprised of a number of townships, boroughs, and precincts. The Committee Members from each region shall include that region's Regional Committee.
 - The Regional Committee is the critical link in Republican Party communications, both UP and DOWN. Rapid and accurate communications shall be facilitated by establishing and using an effective "Communication Tree" via email or phone - what works best for your Region.
 - Regional Captain. The Regional Committee shall meet and elect a Regional Captain (see Article VII Adams County Republican Committee Bylaws).
 - Regional Captains are responsible for disseminating information, upcoming events, and meetings to all Committee Members. Effective techniques include sending emails, holding a brief information meeting, individual personal contact, etc.
 - Each Committee Member should have communications from their Regional Captain monthly, more frequent as we approach election dates.



- Local (Precinct) Committee Member Organization
 - Your neighborhood networking of friends and neighbors.
 - Your responsibility to establish and maintain.
 - As informal or structured as you want.
 - As large or small as you want.
 - Your primary source of help and volunteers when you need assistance.
