Wildscape - Carla Stang

Nothing much happening in the Wildscape for December other than the team will be putting down some mulch around the new plants to tuck them in for the winter. For those who are interested...there are lots of the Esperanza (Orange Jubilee – a cultivar of "Yellow Bells"/ Tecoma sans) seed pods ripening on the 2 plants in the Wildscape that you are welcome to harvest. Please take only those pods that are brown and dried and about to split open. This variety of plant loves the full, hot sun; can tolerate virtually any soil type and will grow quickly to over 10 feet tall and 6 feet wide unless you keep it under control; thrives on very low water and is a great pollinator plant for bees, butterflies, and hummers.
