



## **HUNT GARDEN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

### **About the Program**

The Hunt Garden Club Scholarship Program is sponsored by the Hunt Garden Club through its Scholarship Committee to recognize graduating high school seniors from Hunt, Ingram and Mountain Home, Texas, for academic excellence and service to their schools and communities.

### **Eligibility**

The Hunt Garden Club Scholarship Program is open to high school seniors who live in Hunt, Ingram and Mountain Home and enroll in a two-year or four-year college or university in Texas in the 2020 summer or fall semester. Three \$1200 scholarships are available and may be awarded to applicants who are enrolled in 12 or more credit hours. Awarded students will be required to submit proof of college acceptance for the summer/fall 2020 semester before the start of that semester. Proof of acceptance, consisting of registration documents and/or verification of enrollment from the Bursar's/Registrar's office, must be received by the Scholarship Committee 14 days prior to the first day of the semester in which the student has enrolled. Upon receiving this proof, the Scholarship Committee will send the awarded funds to the college or university where the recipient will complete his/her continuing education.

The Scholarship Committee, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to not award one or more scholarships.

### **Application Process**

Each applicant is required to submit a scholarship packet which must include the following documents:

- (1) A completed application (attached) in blue or black ink;
- (2) A one to two page typed essay enumerating the most outstanding achievements and strengths of our country and the reasons for those choices;
- (3) An official high school transcript as of 12/31/19 (bearing a raised seal and in a sealed envelope);
- (4) Two signed letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, faith-based minister, or community member.\*

**Application packets must be received by Friday, March 13, 2020 and become the property of the Hunt Garden Club. Eligible candidates will be invited to a mandatory interview with the HGC Scholarship Committee. Winners will be contacted no later than May 31, 2020.**
