Practicing Integrated Care

Our behavioral health team understands that physical health and emotional health go hand in hand. They work with patients and their Wood River Health medical providers to help them improve their quality of life.

Patients are given support and resources to help them manage their chronic health conditions, anxiety, depression, life changes, relationship issues and grief or loss.

Our Behavioral Health Services

Wood River Health offers the following programs to help our patients improve their emotional and physical well-being.

Individual and Group Therapy

We offer many types of individual therapy and group support sessions for patients to learn recovery strategies, build interpersonal skills and develop their support networks. Visit our website to learn about our current programs.

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Program

Our MAT Program is one of the safest and most effective options for patients living with a Substance Use Disorder.

The program provides education services, counseling, recovery support and medications to help patients on their path to recovery from nicotine, alcohol or opioid use. The cost is covered by Medicaid and by most private insurance companies.

Peer Support Services

Peer Recovery Specialists provide understanding, support, mentoring, encouragement and hope. They have lived experience and are thriving in their recovery.

Tobacco Cessation Program

This program is open to patients ages 16 and above who want to live a tobacco-free lifestyle. Participants receive support, strategies and medication recommendations.
