

Updated Covid-19 Guidelines

Effective Date: June 16, 2021

1. Masks are not required for fully vaccinated people but masks are still encouraged for unvaccinated individuals when indoors. However, anyone who is still more comfortable wearing a mask may do so.
2. We will maintain the current distancing of 6 feet.
3. Congregational singing is permitted as long as distancing continues.
4. We will continue prepackaged communion and offering drop boxes for now or until Worship Team determines how they would like to proceed as part of the worship services.
5. Hand sanitizer will still be made available and hand washing is encouraged.
6. We will continue to routinely and consistently sanitize high contact surfaces and areas (e.g., doorknobs, equipment, workstations, and restrooms).
7. Employees and congregants will be informed through prominently posted signage not to enter the building if they are sick.
8. Groups may use the church facilities. Masks are recommended for unvaccinated individuals when indoors. Social distancing is still encouraged especially if unvaccinated persons are in attendance. Food handling is the responsibility of the group using the facility and the church accepts no responsibility regarding their decisions.
9. We will continue tracking attendance and encourage individuals who become ill with Covid-19 and have attended one of the services or activities to notify church officials so this information may be passed on.
10. Should the governor's office or the CDC revise their guidelines, ours will be revised accordingly.
