Scriptures: Genesis 2:7-9, 15-17; Revelation 22:1-5

Focus Verses:

In the middle of the garden were the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Genesis 2:9b NIV

On each side of the river was the tree of life, which bears fruit twelve times a year, once each month; and its leaves are for the healing of the nations. Revelation 22:2 GNT
