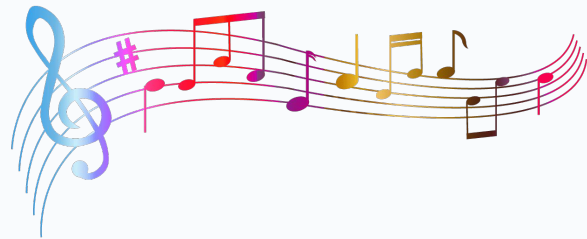

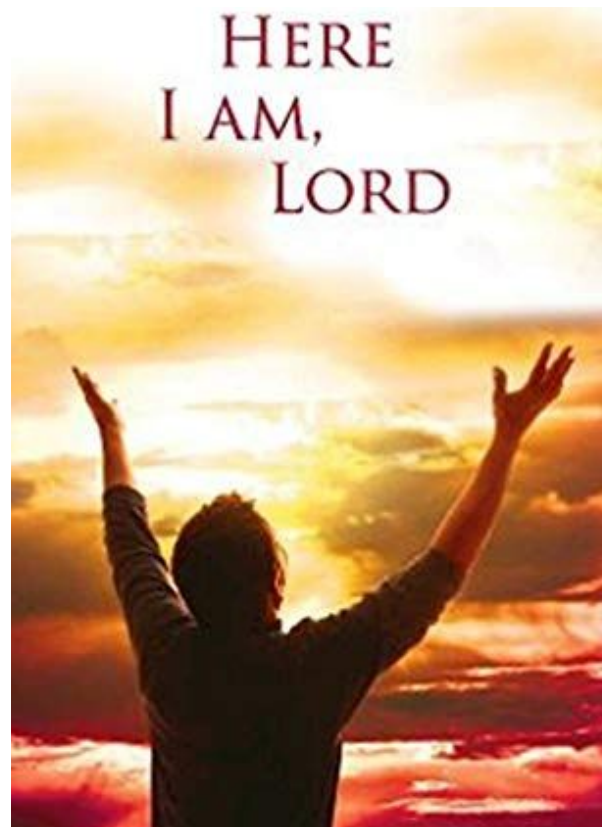


Invitation to Give & Reception of Offering
