NO-SEW FLEECE BLANKET INSTRUCTIONS

Small Hands. Big Hearts. Creating Kindness.

Thank you for helping us create a Comfort Cover!

Your handmade blanket will be donated locally to sick or traumatized children, first responders, homeless persons, veterans, seniors or other important souls in our community.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Two pieces of 50" x 60" anti-pill fleece
- Sharp fabric scissors
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Optional: 4" x 4" cardboard square to use as a cutting guide

1 LAYER THE FLEECE



Lay both pieces of fleece flat, one directly on top of the other, with the pretty/right sides facing out. Smooth out wrinkles and line up the edges evenly.

2 TRIM IF NEEDED



If the pieces aren't perfectly even, carefully trim the edges so both layers are the same size (about 50" x 60").

3 CUT OUT THE CORNERS



Cut a 4" x 4" square from all four corners, cutting through both layers of fleece.

4 CUT THE FRINGE



Working through both layers at the same time, cut 4-inch-deep strips approximately 1 inch wide around all four sides of the blanket. Try to keep the strips consistent, but they don't have to be perfect!

5 TIE THE LAYERS TOGETHER



Take one top strip and the matching bottom strip and tie them together using a snug double knot. Continue around the entire blanket until every pair of fringe pieces is tied.

6 FINAL CHECK



Make sure:

- All fringe pieces are securely tied.
- No pins, tags, stickers or loose materials remain.
- The blanket is clean and ready to provide a little extra comfort to someone who needs it.

7 FINISHED!



You did it!
