

## SAFETY CORNER

#### TELEMARKETERS, SCAMS AND ANNOYING PHONE CALLS

Although general day-to-day activities have been slowed down by the COVID-19 pandemic, it seems that certain types of crime happen no matter what is occurring in the world.

One such example now that people are home more often, is in regards to abusive phone calls. Abusive phone calls are not acceptable. In these cases, callers use the phone for a variety of reasons.

They may intend the call to be a simple prank. Or the call may be a more deliberate attempt to disturb or annoy you. More seriously, the call may be obscene, harassing, and/or threatening.

Calls of this nature may be illegal, punishable by criminal prosecution, and/or may subject the caller to civil liability.

We've all been subject to annoying, pointless, and harassing phone calls from telemarketers.



Be very suspicious of any unknown caller who says that you must respond immediately to the solicitation, offers to pick up the money from your home, instructs you to send or wire money, or claims to be a law enforcement officer who will help you in return for a fee. If you think that the call may be legitimate, but you don't want to purchase anything or make any contributions, just politely tell the caller:

1. You are not interested

 You don't want to waste their time by listening to a solicitation in which you are not interested (although sometimes staying on the phone with them for long periods of time, will take their time away from trying to bother others)
 You would like the caller to remove your name from their calling list.
 If the telemarketer persists in calling you, or if you suspect fraud and want to report it, contact the Office of the Attorney General in your state, your local consumer protection officer, and your local Better Business Bureau.

## SAFETY CORNER CONTINUED

To stop most commercial telemarketing calls, you can register your phone numbers with the National Do Not Call Registry.

You can register online at www.donotcall.gov or call (888) 382-1222. Your registration will not expire. Once your number has been on the registry for 31 days, most telemarketing calls will stop. However, you still may get:

1. Calls from or on behalf of political organizations, charities, and telephone surveyors

2. Calls from companies with whom you have an existing business relationship.

A company may call you for 18 months after you make a purchase or three months after you submit an inquiry or application. However, if you request that the company place your number on its own do-not-call list, they must honor your request. You should keep a record of the date you make the request.

3. Calls from companies you've given permission to call

Another way to reduce the amount of telemarketing calls and advertising mail you receive is to visit www.optoutprescreeen.com and ask to have your name removed from their call or mail lists.Under consumer help. Within months of your request, the volume of calls and/or mail you receive should be reduced.

Your request will remain valid for five years; after that time you will have to reregister. (Phil Reed Personal note) In the past few months I have received several calls from someone pretending to be from Duke Energy that they are going to turn off the power if I do not pay them right away by getting a gift card and giving them the number.

This is a SCAM Duke energy does not EVER make that type of call and tell you to go get a gift card hang up on them.
