#### ♦ Worship Next Week ♦

Advent Three - Zephaniah is the fourth last book of the Old Testament containing a short three chapters. It was written around 630 B.C. dealing with the consequences of sin, and a call to humility before God. It begins with a warning, moves into a discussion about the corrupt nature of Jerusalem and moves into a song of joy for God's salvation and removal of judgment once the people have changed their ways.

Today's Gospel involves John's call to the people to look within and notice what is holding then back from following God that they claimed to believe in. This is a call to people of all time to review their actions and determine if they are living with generosity and justice. Perhaps, John's words have a biting edge and may cause us to wince a little as we reflect on whether we continue to live up to our calling as Jesus' disciples. As we move along in our faith journey, do you find John's words challenging, inspiring, encouraging or discouraging? Think about what motivates you in your own faith journey.
