The Worship Committee is looking for volunteers to lead some of these services and for your creative ideas on how best to meet your needs, especially in July and August. We have lots of resources to assist you.



### Minister's Corner

From Leap in Faith - United Church 2004 Confirmation Resource - These are statements of Characteristics of a Radical Christian Lifestyle: Communal Living – sharing property and goods in common; Non-Violence – will not resort to violence even to defend oneself: Vow of Poverty - Keep only what is needed for basic survival, keep no savings and no financial security; Voluntary Simplicity - reject a consumer lifestyle including TVs and cars; Itinerancy voluntary homelessness, relying on others to take you in; Hospitality - welcome strangers and be generous with all you have; Celibacy - relate as brother or sister, no lover; Spiritual Practice - engage in prayer, meditation regularly; Church Membership - be part of a faith community that gathers for worship, reflection and service; Being a Hermit – Withdraw from society and live separate from community, no distractions from God; Tithing - devote 10 per cent income to church: Volunteerism - devote time and money to worthy causes; Instilling Values - raise my family according to Christian principles.

Now this list goes on for another three pages. As you can see it is pretty radical. I'm not sure even the most devout would be able to live up to all these principles. Each of us as Christians decide how far we will go in our devotion to God. The radical Christian lifestyle is certainly one in which all sense of self is eradicated in favour of the greater good of humankind.
