What are the Four Gospels?

### The Simple Answer

The word gospel means good news. The first four books of the New Testament are known as the four Gospels because they tell the good news about Jesus! The four Gospels are Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. They were written by people who actually walked and talked with Jesus.

Matthew, Mark, Luke focus on the life and teachings of Jesus because they share many similar stories, they are called Synoptic Gospels. This word means "look alike". The Gospel of John is written in a very different style and looks back in time at Matthew, Mark and Luke, revealing their spiritual meaning.

The 4 Gospels are doors that we open to discover Jesus!
