A Public Service Announcement From Our Healthcare Workers!



Remember to get your vaccines! Influenza and RSV will start to take off in December, and covid is with us year-round. Almost everyone should have a flu vaccine and covid vaccine every fall, and some people should have a covid vaccine in the spring, as well. These are available without a prescription in pharmacies. The RSV vaccine is a relatively new vaccine that shown to be safe and effective at keeping people out of hospital. If you've had it, you don't need to have it again. If you haven't had it, it is covered for the first time this year for people over 75 years, and some high-risk people over 60 years. There is a new pneumonia vaccine in the last year, called Prevnar-20; one dose for everyone over 65 years, and for people at high risk of any age. If you've had the older pneumonia vaccine, you should still get this new one. Finally, shingles vaccine, Shingrix, is useful at any age, if you haven't had it. It is publicly funded for people between age 65 to 70 years, and available at cost (around \$200 * 2 doses) for anyone. If you've had two doses of this, you don't need to have it again. If you have allergies to any vaccine components, discuss vaccines with your family doctor.




Canadian Orpheus Male Choir Annual Christmas Concert
