



Dress Code

HAIR MUST BE PULLED BACK AND OUT OF FACE
NO JEWELRY IN CLASS EXCEPT STUDS FOR PIERCED EARS

Combo Class

- Pink, black, or blue leotard with pink or black tights.
- Pink leather ballet slippers & tan patent tap shoes for class.

Ballet

Hair in bun if long enough, pulled out of face otherwise

- Pink tights with black leotards.
- Lower levels must have full sole pink ballet slippers.
- Upper levels can be split or full sole pink ballet slippers.
- NO HALF SOLES IN BALLET

Tap

- Any combo of leotard, fitted tank or tee, leggings, brief or (reasonably) flared legging.
- Some instructors may allow looser fitting clothing. PLEASE CHECK WITH INSTRUCTOR FIRST.
- Lace-up black tap shoes required for class.
- Individual teachers will inform students what is required for recital.

Jazz, Leaps & Turns, and Musical Theater

- Any combo of leotard, fitted tank or tee, supportive dance bras/crop tops, leggings, briefs or flared leggings.
- Some instructors may allow looser fitting clothing. PLEASE CHECK WITH INSTRUCTOR FIRST.
- Any split sole Jazz shoe is acceptable for class.
- Individual teachers will inform students what is required for recital.

Contemporary and Lyrical

- Any combo of leotard, fitted tank or tee, supportive dance bras/crop tops, leggings, briefs or flared leggings.
- Some instructors may allow looser fitting clothing. PLEASE CHECK WITH INSTRUCTOR FIRST.
- Capezio Hanami Pirouette in students' skin tone.

Hip Hop

- Any comfortable clothing. No jeans, stiff pants, crop tops or dance bras. T-shirts and sweatpants/joggers are acceptable.
- Any comfortable sneaker is acceptable for class. PLEASE NOTE: Shoes for Hip Hop are to be worn only for class so our dance floors remain clean and safe.
- Individual teachers will inform students what shoes are required for recital.

NOTE: Specific shoes for competition classes will be chosen by instructors within the first few weeks.
