Witnessing or Attesting to A Signature Type Notarization

“This is the notarial act that a notarial officer will perform in a situation where there is no notarial wording already present on the record and the person requesting the notarial act simply wants their signature to be notarized. ...”

“Unless a person requesting a notarial act requests a different notarial act, Witnessing or Attesting To A Signature is most likely the correct notarial act to perform, which requires a certificate to attach to the record to indicate a notarial act has been performed.” *[Handbook for Maryland Notaries Public]*
