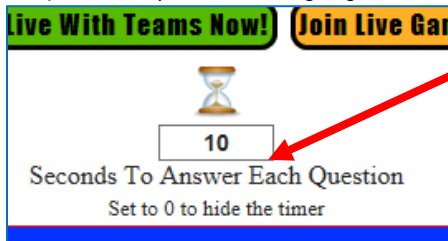


How to Play Jeopardy

The purpose of this fun game is to facilitate learning in a fun way. Read and follow all of the instructions before attempting to play Jeopardy.

1. To access Jeopardy, click on the following link or copy and paste the link into your web browser:

2. ***Do not print answer key until you have finished playing Jeopardy. Otherwise, you will defeat the purpose of testing your knowledge in a fun way.***
3. At the top of the web page, set the timer to “30” seconds (*This gives you 30 seconds to answer the questions.*). Highlight “10”; then type in “30” (without the quotes).



4. You can select 5 questions from 5 Jeopardy categories. Total of 25 questions.

1. Certificate/Notarial Wording	2. Math	3. Miscellaneous
4. History	5. Unusual Requests	

5. Select the question you prefer first. The next screen will quickly appear (See #6.)

6. Remember, you have 30 seconds to answer the Jeopardy question; your answer will be in the form of a question. You will see the number under the timer going down from 30 to 0 seconds.

For example, Question: "Name an antiquated notarial act." Answer: "What is a "protest"?"

The Notary compels truthfulness from the signer.



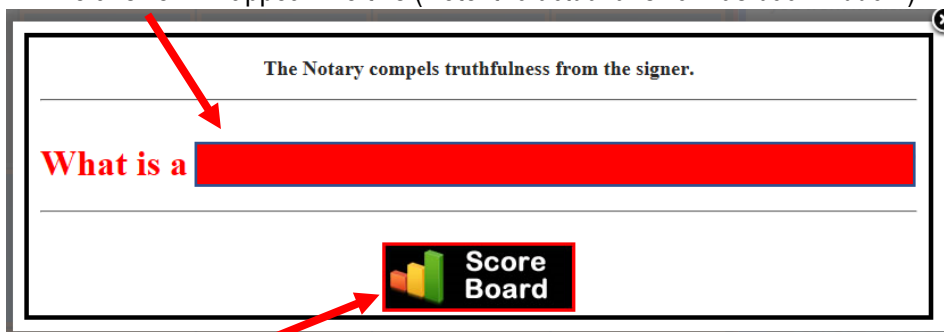

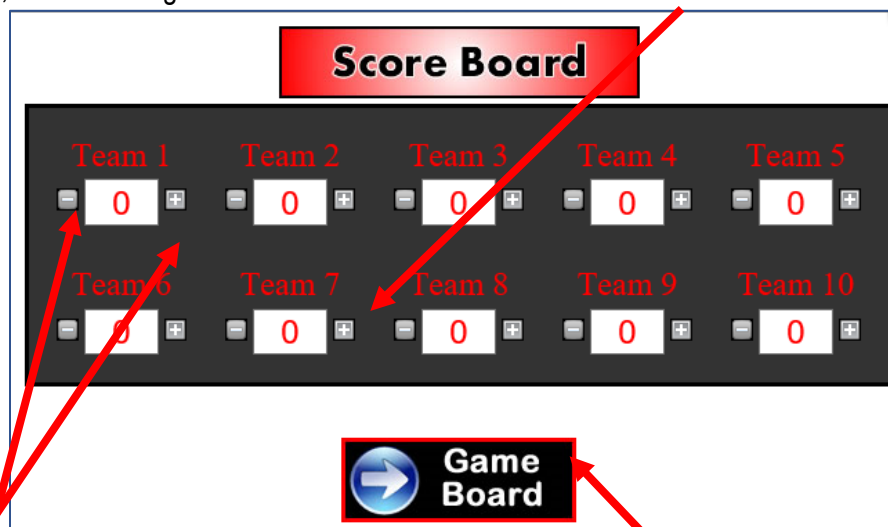
 **View Answer**

7. The answer will appear like this (Note: *the actual answer has been hidden.*):



8. Next, click here to go to **Score Board**.



- If you answered correctly, click the "+" sign for Team 1.
- If you answered incorrectly, click the "-" sign for Team 1.
- Next, click on "Game Board" to return to the Jeopardy screen.

9. Repeat the steps 5 - 8 until all questions have been selected. After all questions are selected, go to the next step.

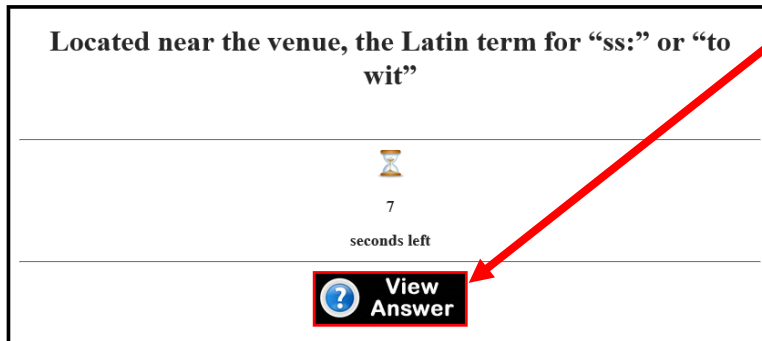
10. Click the "**Final Question**" at the end of the Game Board to answer that question.

11. The following screen will appear. Write down on a piece of paper how many points of your total score you choose **to risk** – the amount depends on how many points you have accumulated. Then, click **“Go To The Final Question”**.

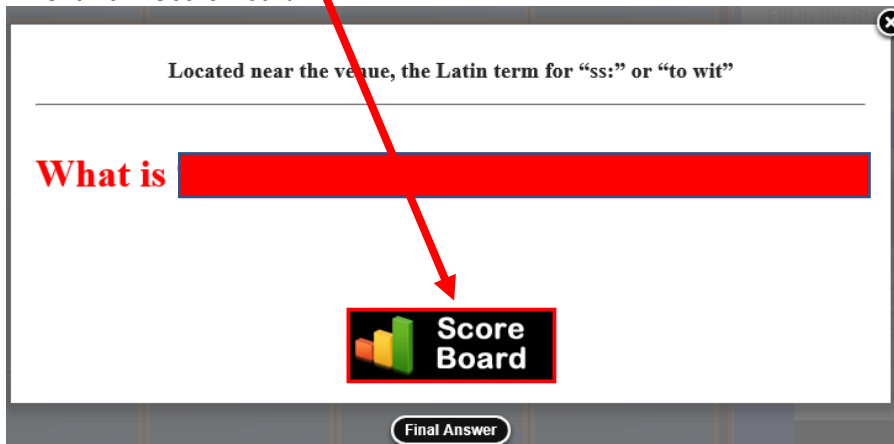


12. The following screen will appear. To view the correct answer, click **“View Answer”**.



13. The following screen will appear with the correct answer.

14. Click on **“Score Board”**.



15. If your answer is correct, add the “amount risked” to your score.
16. If your answer is incorrect, subtract the “amount risked” to your score.
17. A total of 4,000 point is a passing score. Maximum points = 7,500 – **Congratulations!**
18. Close this window by clicking the “x” in the upper right corner of this window.

19. You will return to the main screen.

20. Scroll up to the top of the Game Board Page (home page). Print the game answer key for your records.
