terminal operators, shipping lines, and shipyard managers to voluntarily and measurably reduce their environmental footprint.

The comprehensive program addresses key environmental challenges through 12 distinct performance indicators, including reducing air emissions, minimizing community impacts, and demonstrating environmental leadership. Founded in 2007, Green Marine is a rigorous, transparent, and inclusive initiative that encourages members to



adopt concrete, measurable actions beyond regulatory compliance. More than 120 participants—including ship owners, port authorities, terminal operators, and shipyards—across Canada and the United States are involved.

Green Marine certification supports Port Detroit's commitment to achieving net-zero carbon emissions by 2050.

DWCPA is currently undergoing its first Green Marine bi-annual verification, which will assess how the 12 performance indicators are being implemented. The results will be published as soon as they are available.
