

Sir James Knott Nursery School Nursery Hub and 30 Hours/ Wraparound Provision Model

At Sir James Knott Nursery School, we will;

- Provide a happy, safe, stimulating and challenging learning environment in which children will be exposed to the awe and wonder of play, which will support all children on their lifelong journey.
- Provide a broad, balanced, relevant and creative curriculum that will set in place firm foundations for future learning and development in First and Primary Schools and beyond and enable choice and decision making, fostering independence and self-confidence.
- Use and value what each child can do, assessing their individual needs and helping each child to progress.
- Develop excellent relationships with parents and carers to build a strong partnership in supporting their children.
- Provide a caring and inclusive learning environment which is sensitive to the requirements of the individual child including those who have additional needs.

As part of our curriculum design our Nursery Hub and 30 Hours/ Wraparound Provision provides an integrated model to the delivery of the curriculum. Each session comprises of 3 hours of learning; mornings and afternoons. During this time the children and staff work in collaboration for 1 hour of outdoor learning and 1 hour of project based planning; following the interests of the children.

We pride ourselves upon providing a high quality education for all children and feel our 30 Hours/ Wraparound Provision enables us to be able to provide the children with a little bit of a home from home. We have created our environment to be homely. Within this provision we enjoy cooking, baking, planting and going out within our local community. During both provisions the staff ensure that children's interests are met and that they have a passion for learning.

Following the interests of the children we have devised the following focuses within our 30 Hour/ Wraparound Provision;

Eco Warriors- Children to have a greater awareness of being kind to our planet and supporting school in recycling, switching taps off and ensuring rooms are not left with lights on etc.

Wraparound Bake Off- Children to use their home experiences and cultures to bake and cook with their peers. This will provide a wonderful resource to aid communication and language and mathematical concepts such as measuring.

SJK Community Explorers- Children to become aware of their local environment and to help maintain our wonderful natural world around us such as our allotment and school grounds.

SJK go Dancing- Children to become aware of the different forms of physical activity such as dancing, yoga, meditation- linking with cultures from around the world.

Imaginative Minds- Linking in role play, expressive arts and design, reading and writing.

These focused sessions are carried out on a rotating basis each week to ensure that all children have exposure to all these wonderful opportunities and experiences.
