- A waiting list form must be completed for every child attending the provision.
- Waiting list forms will be transferred to electronic format and stored in the main school office and on a shared drive.
- Contact details must be checked after a length of time to ensure that the information is still correct.
- Waiting list forms cannot be transferred from one provision to another.
- The child information form completed on admission must be completed for every child attending the provision.
- All relevant admission paperwork must be handed back to school prior to the child starting. A start date will be delayed if paperwork is not received.
- Child information forms must be checked at intervals and after absences to ensure that the information is still correct.
- Parents/carers must be reminded to inform office staff of any changes to details.
- Registration forms cannot be transferred from one provision to another.
- A parent/carer information sheet should be offered at the children's first attendance to the provision. This should be available to parents/carers electronically and on our school website.
- Parents/carers should be advised that a copy of the Schools Policies and Procedures can be found on our school website. Hard copies can be printed out for parents/carers upon request.
- Admission to Nursery School follows the North Tyneside admission criteria and considers the following elements:
 - Sibling link
 - Geographical location
 - Any SEND requirements
 - Previous contact with the school
- Appeals should be made in writing to the Headteacher as soon as possible. These
 will be considered by the Governing Body and a decision made within an agreed
 timescale. Parents/carers will be kept fully informed at all times.
