## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Dickerson moved to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on July 17, 2024, and Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. In the affirmative: Mr. Cochran, Mr. Dickerson and Mr. Stewart. In the negative: None.

Chief McCann Report – (Attached)

Chief McCann reported that the Dot Program had been completed for Milford, the Village, South Bloomfield, and Hilliar.

The citation hearing for TRGG Holding LLC (Hackett) is Friday at 9:30 at the Ohio Board of Building Appeals, Division of Industrial Compliance.

Oxygen Bottle rental is now estimated at \$240/month.

On Chief McCann's recommendation, Mr. Stewart made a motion to approve Paramedic School tuition for FF Gebel, and Mr. Cochran seconded. In the affirmative: Mr. Cochran, Mr. Dickerson and Mr. Stewart. In the negative: None. The tuition is estimated to be \$8000 estimate. COJFD may be able to obtain another Ohio Means Jobs grant to cover the tuition.

Mr. Stewart proposed a resolution to receive the Ohio Means Jobs Grant for Incumbent Worker Training in the amount of \$6,912.00 and the funds to reimburse Central Ohio Joint Fire District 90% of FF Poole's medic class tuition, per grant guidelines. Mr. Dickerson seconded.

Mr. Dickerson proposed a resolution to receive the Bureau of Workers Compensation Grant in the amount of \$30,396.02, and Mr. Cochran seconded.

Mr. Stewart made a motion to use the Bureau of Workers Compensation Grant funds to cover 75% of the Stryker stair-chairs in the amount of \$30,396.02, with COJFD being responsible for 10% in the amount of \$10,132.00. Mr. Stewart seconded. In the affirmative: Mr. Cochran, Mr. Dickerson and Mr. Stewart. In the negative: None.

Mr. Dickerson proposed a resolution to receive the Ohio Ambulance Impact Grant in the amount of \$105,794.00, effective July 22, 2024, and appropriate the grant money to payroll for employee retention, in compliance with the grant. Mr. Stewart seconded.

Mr. Dickerson made a motion to have the Fiscal Officer transfer \$10,000.00 of Operating Expenses - Building (100-220-420-0003) to Contracted Services - Building (1000-220-360-0003), and Mr. Stewart seconded. In the affirmative: Mr. Cochran, Mr. Dickerson and Mr. Stewart. In the negative: None.

Mr. Cochran made a motion to have the Fiscal Officer transfer \$2000.00 out of Audit Services (100-220-312-0000) to Operating Supplies - Office (1000-220-420-0005), and Mr. Dickerson seconded. In the affirmative: Mr. Cochran, Mr. Dickerson and Mr. Stewart. In the negative: None.

Chief McCann shared that presently COFJD has more people on the full-time list off probation than on probation for the first time in 5 years. The pay raises at the beginning of the year have had a positive impact on employee retention.

On Chief McCann's suggestion, Mr. Stewart motioned to offer conditional job offers to Paramedic Rob Glaze at \$19/hour, EMT Tylerlee Jones at \$17/hour, and t EMT John Baldinelli at \$17/hour. Mr.

Dickerson seconded. In the affirmative: Mr. Cochran, Mr. Dickerson and Mr. Stewart. In the negative: None.
