**December 1, 2024** - First Sunday of Advent

Candle to be lit: **HOPE**

Scripture: Luke 21:25-36

**Sermon Scripture: Luke 21:36 Be alert at all times, praying that you may have the strength to escape all these things that will take place, and to stand before the Son of Man."**

Theme: Pay Attention

**December 8, 2024** - Second Sunday of Advent

Sunday December 8, 2024

Candle to be lit: **PEACE**

Second Sunday after Advent

Scripture: Luke 3:1-6

**Sermon Scripture: Luke 3:4 as it is written in the book of the words of the prophet Isaiah, "The voice of one crying out in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the Lord; make his paths straight.**

Theme: Prepare the way of the Lord

December 15, 2024 - Third Sunday of Advent: Gaudete Sunday (rejoice)

Candle to be lit: **JOY**

**Scripture: Philippians 4:4-7**

**Sermon Scripture: Philippians 4:4 Rejoice in the Lord always; again I will say, Rejoice.**

Theme: Rejoice in the Lord

**December 22, 2024 - Fourth Sunday of Advent**

**Candle to be lit: LOVE**

**Scripture: Luke 1:39-45, (46-55)**

**Sermon Scripture: Luke 1:46-50 And Mary said, "My soul magnifies the Lord, 47 and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior, 48 for he has looked with favor on the lowly state of his servant. Surely from now on all generations will call me blessed, 49 for the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name; 50 indeed, his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation.**

**Theme: The Lord is with us!**

**December 24, 2024 - Christmas Eve**

**Candle to be lit: **Center Candle****

**Scripture: Luke 2:1-14, (15-20)**

**Sermon Scripture - Luke 2: 10-11 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for see, I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord.**

**Theme: Joy to the World, the Lord has come!**

**December 29, 2024 - First Sunday after Christmas**

**Scripture - Luke 2:41-52**

**Sermon Scripture: Luke 2:51-52 Then he went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was obedient to them, and his mother treasured all these things in her heart. And Jesus increased in wisdom and in years and in divine and human favor.**
