One of the new books is <u>The Power of Together</u> by Jim Putman. This book explores how building relationships within the church can strengthen and deepen our own Christian faith. People are meant to be in families and groups that care for, love, and listen to one another. The author gives examples of how being part of a spiritual family helps individuals navigate the challenges in their lives. He describes how families love each other no matter what, can prevent problems and be restorative. Sometimes we think we can just make it alone without any help or support. Even Jesus brought diverse people close to him and his ministry. He loves them even when they weren't lovable. This book looks at the importance of "doing life" in close fellowship with other believers bringing you closer to others and to Jesus.
