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Adam Wyatt is a professional guitarist and full-time musician with more than 30 years of experience on the guitar and more than two decades as a full-time performer. He began playing at age 12 and studied with several noteworthy guitarists throughout his teenage years, developing the musicianship that would become the foundation of his career.

At 20, Adam began performing with the Adam Wyatt Electric Band while also establishing himself as a solo acoustic performer. Since then, he has performed thousands of shows throughout the Midwest and across the country, appearing at clubs, festivals, fairs, casinos, and major events.

Adam spent seven years as a weekly solo performer at Blayney's of Westport, the legendary Kansas City blues club, performing hundreds of shows on the club's main stage. He has also performed at numerous blues and jazz festivals and has shared the stage with nationally recognized artists including Bo Diddley, Black Oak Arkansas, Tab Benoit, Bernard Allison, Chris Duarte, Corey Stevens, Craig Morgan, and others.

In 2009, Adam opened Wyatt Music Center in Odessa, Missouri, where he has built and maintained a successful music business and teaching facility. Over the years, he has taught hundreds of guitar students, with several going on to successful careers in music. Many continue to credit Adam as a major influence on their playing and frequently cite him as their teacher when discussing their own development as musicians.

His career has also included numerous television and radio appearances. Recent highlights include performing on the FOX morning show, opening for Craig Morgan, and performing at fairs and festivals throughout the region. Adam was also selected by Hy-Vee to perform weekly for four years at its Market Grille locations, a residency that concluded during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Today, Adam performs as a solo artist specializing in classic rock, blues, and country, combining advanced guitar work, vocals, foot percussion, and professional production. His show is intentionally designed to deliver the musical impact and energy of a full band while maintaining an exceptionally small footprint.

Adam's performance is not simply a singer strumming a guitar. His arrangements are built around high-level guitar playing, rhythm, dynamics, and decades of live performance experience. The result is a polished, energetic, high-level musical performance that puts musicianship at the center of the show.
