## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All items for sale are to be home made, home grown, and home produced. **NO SECOND-HAND, COMMERCIALY MADE OR IMPORTED GOODS WILL BE PERMITTED.** Sale of Livestock is not accepted.
2. Market trading runs from
  - 8am to 1pm in April, May, June, July, August, September inclusive with stallholders off the oval by 1.30pm.
  - 7.30am to 12pm in October, November, December, January, February, March inclusive due to cricket as set by Cricket Australia and off the oval by 12.30pm
  - Gates close to vehicle entry at 7.30am and re-open for vehicle departure at 12pm in summer and 1pm in winter. Gates will be locked at 12.30pm summer & 1.30pm winter. Any vehicles not exiting by this time will be subject to a call out fee for gates to be opened.
3. All food and drink stalls must comply with relative government and other statutory authority regulations. Copies of food registration certificates are to be provided to the committee. All food stalls are to provide their own rubbish bins and leave the area around their site free of rubbish. The sale of cans of soft drink and other commercially made drinks is not allowed.
4. Stallholders are requested to adhere to selling only products they initially book in to sell, and not add to their stall without first checking with the committee.
5. Payment of fees is not determined by the weather. Sorry no refunds. Credit notes will be issued when the market is required by the Shire to not operate due to extreme weather conditions.
6. Sites must be left clean and tidy. Please take your rubbish home with you. The market bins are for customers' use only.
7. Sites on average are 3.0m frontages x4.0m depths. No part of the stall can extend into the walkway. This includes the use of sandwich-boards signs. **Each stallholder must provide their own mat(s)** to reduce wear spots from standing in the same spot for the market. All Marquees and shelters must be securely fixed using weights. **No pegs may be used.**
8. All Covid related Government requirements must be adhered to. We recommend the use of hand sanitiser and advising customers to socially distance when required.
9. Sites are not transferable.
10. Spruiking and the use of microphones/amplifiers is not allowed. Religious and Political stalls are not allowed.
11. The Boneo Community Market committee may refuse entry to any vendor or prospective vendor if craft/produce or conduct is unacceptable. Stallholders may not use social media in any way that is negative or derogatory towards the market or other stallholders. Stallholders not abiding by the rules and regulations will be asked to leave the market.
12. Stallholders are advised to obtain their own property and personal accident insurance cover and to provide us with a copy.
13. Boneo Community Market committee reserves the right to move stallholders to other sites at our discretion. We reserve the right to prevent trucks and heavy vehicles from driving on the oval after heavy rain if we believe they will cause damage to the surface. We will relocate all heavy vehicles to alternative spots outside the oval where they can set up.
14. Cancellation policy for casual stallholders -  
Sites are not confirmed until payment has been received. If payments are not received 7 days prior to the market, sites will be released to other prospective stall holders. For casual stallholders cancellations must be notified 7 days prior to the market for a credit note to be issued for the following market. This credit note can only be extended to the next market.  
For Permanent stallholders An absence of more than 2 markets without 7 days notification will forfeit your site including any forward paid site fees.
15. All Stall Bookings close at 12pm on Thursday prior to the market.
