



Hosting a Class at Your Location

To avoid the cost of lodging and travel expenses many agencies prefer to host a class at their location. MERIT makes the process easy and enables the hosting agency to specialize the class to their specific needs. Choosing the class is the first step. Our most popular classes include:

- **Clan Lab Response:** This is a five-day certification course. Students from the law enforcement and first responder communities train to identify, supervise and process a clandestine lab in the field. This is an OSHA compliant class which is often referred to as a basic clan lab class. Ours is much more than basic!
- **Meth Lab Child Interdiction:** This class is designed for both Child Services and Probation & Parole Personnel. The class is 8 hours and prepares the student to visually identify clandestine drug labs, and identify the specific hazards found in each one.
- **Meth Lab Special Operations:** In this course all the information presented in the Clan Lab Response class is included but also includes tactical entry training into a clan lab incident! This is one of our fastest paced courses. Students investigate, raid and process a clan lab during training.

These are just a few of the classes offered. Now that you have chosen the class for your agency you will need to determine the dates which suit your calendar. Once the class and dates are chosen MERIT will ask that you provide a classroom type setting large enough to seat the class attendance. Class attendance can be determined by the hosting agency. Lastly, if you are hosting a five-day class we will need a location for mock drills. Don't worry this can be a burn house, vehicles, shed etc. Now MERIT will do the rest.

MERIT will produce training brochures for your specific class, place it on the website and send class notifications to surrounding agencies with your permission. MERIT requires a minimum of ten officers to present the class. If you don't have ten, don't worry we will help to create the attendance.
