BASIC CLANDESTINE LAB CERTIFICATION: 40-hour class based on HAZWOPER criteria for personnel who will be processing clandestine lab sites. Students will be a part of more than 10,000 other personnel who have attended the best training in the nation. Students will be trained in clandestine lab investigation based on expert level understanding of illicit techniques used to manufacture meth, fentanyl, and marijuana. When complete, students can safely and effectively process a clan lab utilizing the appropriate personal protective equipment and protocols. **Tuition \$550.00**

ANNUAL CLAN LAB REFRESHER: 8-hour class for personnel previously certified in clan Lab operations this course serves to update the student on new trends, equipment and techniques to safely continue their certification. This course meets the annual mandate for clan lab certification renewal. **Tuition \$145.00**

METH LAB CHILD INTERDICTION TRAINING: 8-hours Personnel in child protective services enter homes daily which have a high risk of clandestine drug activity, putting themselves at risk of exposure and harm. Students attending this course will be trained to identify the signs of clandestine lab activity, know the dangers and be taught how to diffuse the situation and reducing the personal risk. **Tuition \$145.00**

METH LAB INTERDICTION COURSE: 8-hours Daily, parole and probation officers enter residences while supervising individuals. With the recidivism rate at nearly 100%, these locations have a high potential of clandestine drug labs and trafficking. In this course officers will be trained to identify the items used in illicit drug labs and trafficking. With an expert knowledge of these items, officers can testify and charge based on their training. **Tuition \$145.00**
