For personnel who have attended a 40-hour Basic Clandestine Lab Certification and need to attend their mandatory annual refresher training to remain current for HAZWOPER Certification, there are three locations hosting this training.

Louisiana: Slidell

Date: May 7, 8 or the 9th 2019. Slidell Louisiana

Location: Slidell Fire Dist. #1 Training Center 34780 S Range Rd, Slidell, LA 70460

Training: 830-4 pm. Training will include lecture updates in the morning. In the afternoon session the class will be broken into teams who will enter a location and determine a response based on their findings. Attending personnel will not be using PPE or Response equipment.

Georgia: St. Marys

Date May 24, 2019

Location: Camden County Sheriff's Office Substation, 6350 Hwy 40, St. Marys, Georgia 31558

Training: 830-4 pm. This recertification is a live drill. Personnel will be wearing personal protective equipment. Personnel should be prepared and groomed for active participation. Generally, this recert requires less time than the lecture based recerts.

Location: Camden County Sheriff's Office Substation, 6350 Hwy 40, St. Marys, Georgia 31558

Training: 830-4 pm. Training will include lecture updates in the morning. In the afternoon session the class will be broken into teams who will enter a location and determine a response based on their findings. Attending personnel will not be using PPE or Response equipment.

West Virginia: West Union

Location: 170 Marie Street, West Union, WV 26456

Training: 830-4 pm. Training will include lecture updates in the morning. In the afternoon session the class will be broken into teams who will enter a location and determine a response based on their findings. Attending personnel will not be using PPE or Response equipment.

Personnel attending one of these courses will receive a certificate of updated training for clandestine lab processing including fentanyl, methamphetamine and marijuana operations.
