

- Adult education at Schools.
- Training at Clinics
- Regular Visits from Health Promoter





#### **Project Status**

- 2,300+ Filters Installed, Over 20,000 People Now Have Access to Clean Water.
- · Networking and raising awareness on water and sanitation issues;
- · Working village by village to spread hygiene knowledge;
- Building biosand filters with local Haitian materials (99%);
- Installing at least 45 filters per month in homes;
- Providing education during installation and follow-up service;
- · Providing long term monitoring and troubleshooting; and
- Providing a successful Haitian business which is sustainable, and technically and financially accountable.

- Begin filter installation in 5 new villages.
- Expand service to NGO's.
- Train 5 community health promoters in the Southeast Province.
