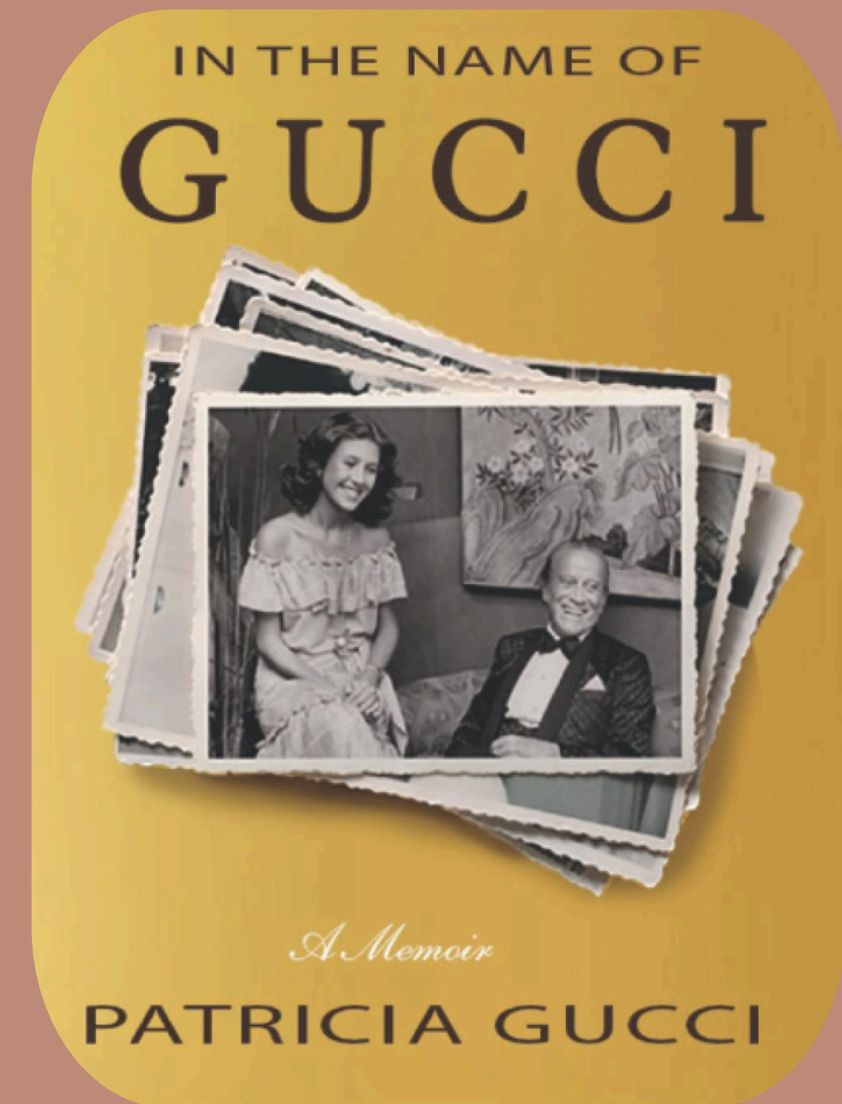
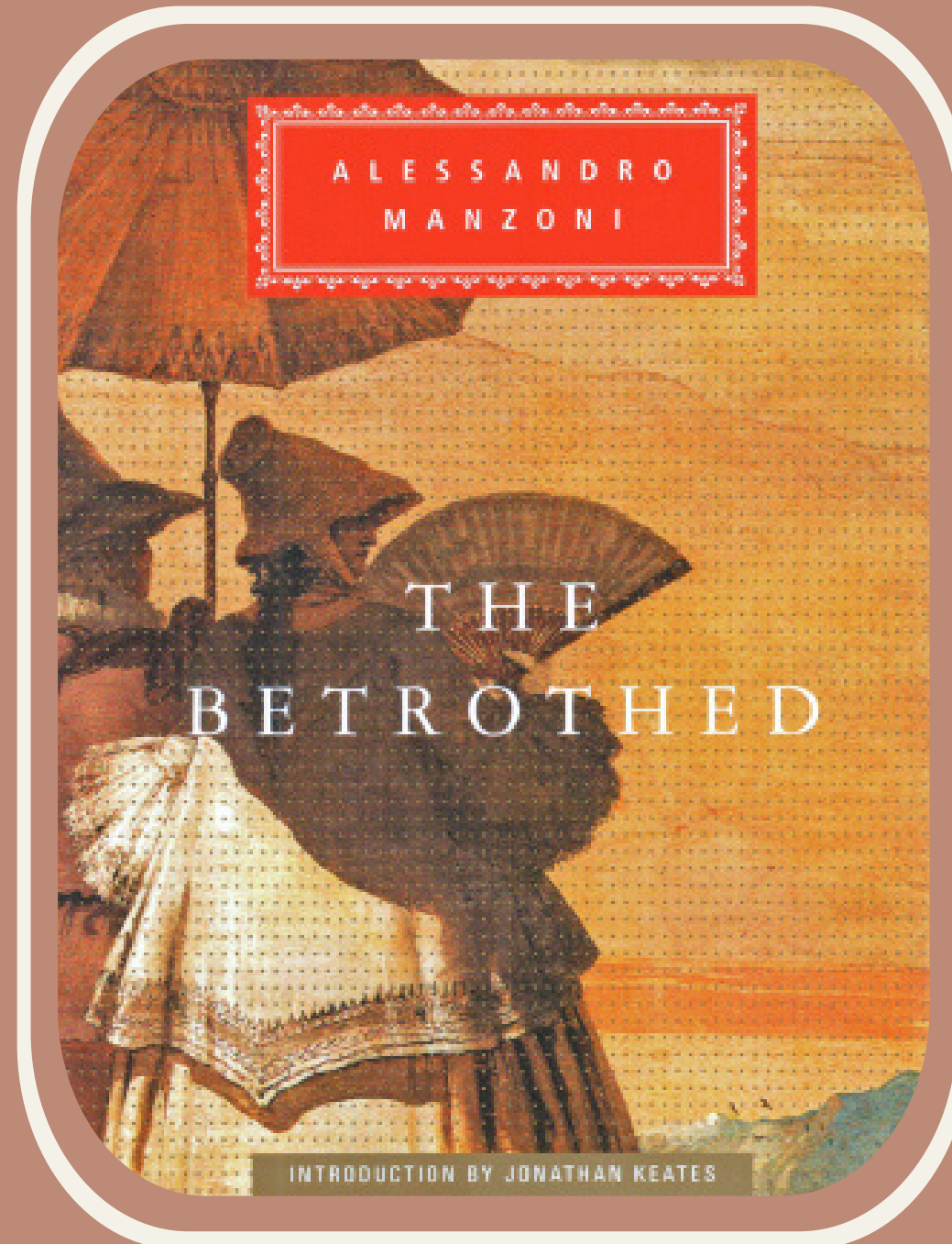
- *The Hidden Canals*

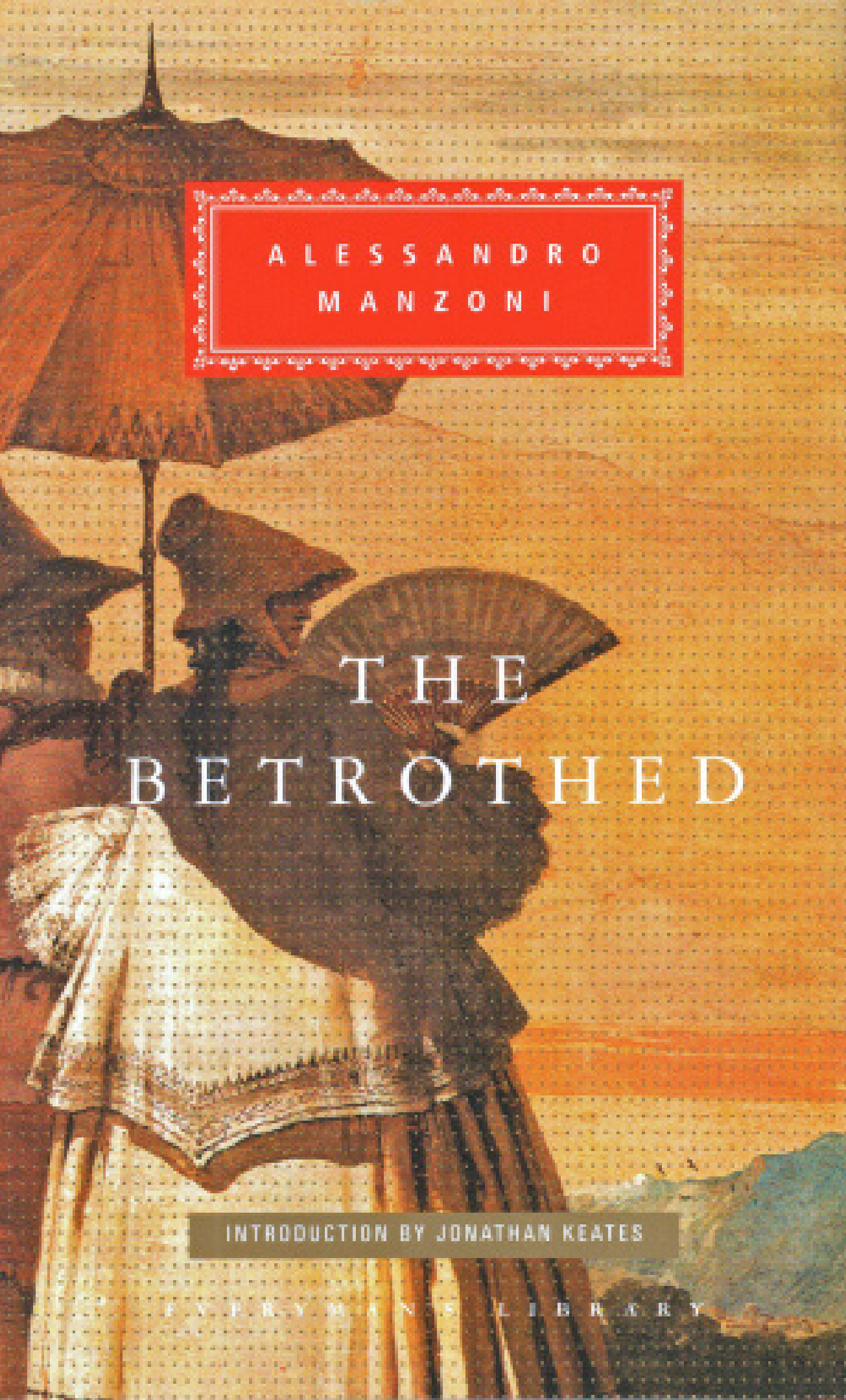
THE SECOND LOFE OF INSPECTOR CANESSA
